January – June 2010 Preliminary Crime Statistics

Data reported as of August 27, 2010

Preliminary figures are derived using MICR (Michigan Incident Crime Reporting) crime statistics reported for the first six months of 2010 from agencies that have jurisdiction for a community with a population of 100,000 or more. Statistics from these agencies are used since they represent the majority of the population for Michigan. The MICR data fluctuates daily and these totals are compiled from data MSP has received from these law enforcement agencies as of August 27, 2010, for the first six months of 2010.

The violent crime totals for these agencies have decreased 5% for the first 6 months when compared to previous year's figures. Murder reported the largest decrease (14%) in the category of **violent crimes**; even though **property crimes** declined 4%, Arson shows a 43% increase.

*The Motor Vehicle Theft category counts the total number of vehicles stolen. Victim crimes (murder, rape, and aggravated assault) count the number of victims. Due to different reporting methodologies, these figures may appear different than those reported by the FBI.

^A crime rate is calculated by dividing the number of reported crimes (violent, property, and arson) by the total population; the result is multiplied by 100,000.
