**Nomination Category Descriptions**

- Outstanding Officer:** Officers who made a difference in 2014 in the area(s) of education, prevention, policy, or enforcement which reduced impaired driving deaths and injuries.
- Outstanding Rookie:** Rookie officers who made a difference in 2014 in the area(s) of education, prevention, policy, or enforcement which reduced impaired driving deaths and injuries. *Rookie is defined as an officer with less than one year of service.*
- Outstanding Law Enforcement Agency:** Law enforcement agencies that made a difference in 2014 in the area(s) of education, prevention, policy, or enforcement which reduced impaired driving deaths and injuries.
- Recognition of Excellence:** Individual or agency working in the area(s) of education, prevention, or innovation to reduce impaired driving in 2014. This might include new or significant approaches to reducing impaired driving or going above and beyond the normal bounds of duty to address impaired driving issues.
- Deputy Lewis Tyler Longevity Award:** Law Enforcement personnel, retired or retiring individual, who made a difference during the course of their law enforcement career in the area(s) of education, prevention, policy, or enforcement which reduced impaired driving deaths and injuries.
- David M. Schieber MADD Lifesaver Award:** Prosecutor who in 2014 demonstrated daily extraordinary above and beyond work; dealt with a high profile or complicated case; provided victim services above the bounds of duty; and/or, addressed a new/significant issue regarding impaired driving, which may include a novel case.
