



Bias/Hate Crimes - Anti-Other Religion Hate Crime

Bias is to be reported *only if* investigation reveals sufficient objective facts to lead a reasonable and prudent person to conclude that the offender's action are motivated, in whole or part, by anti-religious bias.

Some Christian religious organizations do not categorize themselves as either Protestant or Catholic. When this occurs, the hate crime should be coded as Anti-Other Religion.

Example - Mormon

- The Mormon religion is of Christian faith.
- The Mormon religion is not categorized as Protestant or Catholic.
- Anti-Mormon crimes should be coded as "Anti-Other Religion" ("25").

Any single religious group that does not fall under the category of Jewish, Catholic, Protestant, Islamic (Muslim) or Atheist/Agnostic should be coded as Anti-Other Religion.

Anti-Other Religion Groups include

- Buddhism
- Hinduism
- Shintoism
- Mormon
