Overview of Crime in Flint

Violent crime is on a decline from the same time last year in the City of Flint. Robberies, rapes and homicides all have a lower rate in the third quarter than in the previous two quarters. Homicides have decreased 9% compared to the same time in 2012. There have been multiple incidences of crimes that have been connected to the same suspects and there is also a new threat group/gang developing on the west side of the city (see SCP Analysis section).


There are seven "violent crime hotspot areas" recommended for DDACTS patrols in the City of Flint. The hotspots account for 28.28% of the total area and 59.00% of the violent crime in the city. Between July 1, 2013, and September 30, 2013, there were 539 violent crime and weapons offense incidents in the City of Flint. Forty-three percent of all Flint violent crimes and weapons offenses took place in hotspots #1, #2, and #4, with each reporting more than 40 violent crimes and weapons offense incidents.












Flint DDACTS Change Analysis 01OCT13 to 31DEC13 (Hotspot: VC Hotspot: 1)

Hotspot Activity

- **Hotspot 1:**

- ◊ 2 Homicides
- ◊ 13 Shootings

In many of the shootings in this area, the victims were uncooperative with officers. This may be a result of the victim or shooter or both engaging in criminal activity before the shooting. In one incident, the victim knew who the shooter was by name and refused to give the information to police but a witness was able to provide police with the information. A number of the shootings were also a result of arguments between the suspect and victims.

- **Hotspot 2:**

- ◊ 2 Homicides
- ◊ 13 Shootings

The suspects in both of the homicide incidents have been arrested. In one incident, the suspect was taken into custody the same night as the homicide and in the other incident the suspect was captured a few months later in Texas. Many of the incidents in this area were domestic related shootings. In one incident, the suspect shot himself after shooting at his girlfriend and the girlfriend's new boyfriend. In other incidents, the victims were uncooperative as well with many of these incidents happening at parties or large gatherings.

- **Hotspot 3:**

- ◊ 1 Homicide
- ◊ 3 Shootings

- **Hotspot 4:**

- ◊ 0 Homicides
- ◊ 1 Shooting

The shooting incident in this area was allegedly the result of a fight between neighbors and the victim in the shooting was extremely uncooperative with police.

- **Hotspot 5:**

- ◊ 2 Homicides
- ◊ 1 Shooting

The two homicides that occurred in this hotspot were the result of a double homicide. The incident occurred as a result of a domestic situation and the suspect was apprehended the same day after attempting suicide.

- **Hotspot 6:**

- ◊ 0 Homicides
- ◊ 3 Shootings

- **Hotspot 7:**

- ◊ 0 Homicides
- ◊ 4 Shootings

Most of the shooting incidents in this area were results of robberies or a robbery incident. In one shooting incident, a robbery suspect was shot by a bystander who was never located. Another incident had a victim shot in Broom Park but the victim was uncooperative with police.

- **City:**

- ◊ 5 Homicides
- ◊ 39 Shootings

There were 9 incidents of homicide in the 3rd quarter with a total of 12 victims. Two incidents contained multiple victims, one triple homicide and one double. Both the incident count and victim count were lower in the 3rd quarter than the first two quarters of 2013.

- 1st Quarter- 13 homicide victims (12 incidents)
- 2nd Quarter- 14 homicide victims (12 incidents)
 - 58% of the homicide incidents occurred in hotspot areas with Hotspots 1 and 2 being the most prevalent areas both having the highest number of incidents. Hotspot 2 had multiple homicides during a single incident.
 - 75% of the total homicides from this quarter have been solved. Four of the incidents were traced back to the same suspect (see Deonte Gray info below).
 - In 58% of the homicides, the suspect was known to the victim in some way (previous encounters before the homicide). A third of the incidents had no clear information as to whether the suspect knew or met the victim before.



Weapons Offenses

There were approximately 25 concealed weapons incidents from July through the end of September 2013 involving firearms. This resulted in the seizure of 26 handguns/rifles with the following breakdown:

- 1 incident involved the seizure of an assault rifle
- 27% of handguns seized were 9mm
- 35% were .40 caliber handguns
- 23% were .380 caliber handguns

Several of the handguns had the serial numbers scratched or marred, indicating the guns could possibly be stolen. There were a number of others also that were definitively found to be stolen from different burglary/larceny incidents within the city and in surrounding jurisdictions.

Entities with Multiple Incidents

Drifters Motorcycle Club—4010 N Saginaw St, Flint, MI

A number of violent incidents have occurred at this motorcycle club/nightclub over the last three months. In early July, there was a shooting at Drifters during which four different victims were struck by gunfire while in the parking lot. Three of the victims were females and ranged in age from 19-24 YOA.

On August 9, 2013, there were three different incidents that occurred within an hour of each other that all had ties to Drifters. One incident was a domestic assault that occurred in the club, another was a simple assault where a male patron assaulted a female patron and two of her friends when she bumped into him. The third incident that occurred in the early morning hours was a shooting where the victim was shot after getting into an argument with several males outside of the club.

Cruisin' Bar—405 S Dort Hwy, Flint, MI

In early July, there was a shooting where the victim received gunshot wounds to the shoulder. The victim was extremely uncooperative with police and provided several untruthful statements when questioned.


Also in early July, a shooting occurred in the parking lot where the victim, along with two other occupants of his vehicle, was shot. The victim stated to officers that the incident was gang-related and was in reference to him (the victim) being in the Merrill Hood gang. Officers also located a gun on a patron of Cruisin' in mid-July and another patron of the establishment had their .40 cal S&W handgun stolen from their vehicle.

****Not all of these incidents are violent in nature but are indicative of misdemeanor crimes that can occur early on and eventually turn into more violent crimes given the nature of the most recent incidents at these establishments.****

Gang Activity

Money Hungry Clique Squad/"The Squad":

Information gathered by several Flint Police patrol officers from residents reveals that there is a group of young male subjects that have been engaging in various criminal activities in a Westside neighborhood. Many residents have reported burglaries and loitering and complaints have also led to the indication that members of this group have access to or are already in possession of weapons. 




