


Definition: Aggravated/Felonious Assault is an unlawful attack by one person upon another wherein the offender uses a weapon or displays it in a threatening manner, or the victim suffers obvious severe or aggravated bodily injury involving apparent broken bones, loss of teeth, possible internal injury, sever laceration, or loss of consciousness.

Offenses are the unlawful acts reported to a law enforcement agency. Victims are the injured party of the offense.



Age of Victim




There are more victims of aggravated assault between the ages 20 - 24 (5,678) than there were for the 15 -19 year olds (5,629).

Sex of Victim




Fifty-six percent of the victims were reported as being male.

Race of Victim




When race is considered, black victims were reported to be the most targeted in 2007.

Victim to Offender Relationship




The most reported Victim to Offender relationship for Aggravated Assault was "Acquaintance" at 19%. An "Unknown" relationship ranked next at 15.3%.

Weapons Used




The most used weapon was a Blunt Instrument (18.84%). A Knife/Cutting Instrument was reported in 18.28% of the Aggravated Assaults.

Victim Injury



Forty-five percent of the victims received no injury. Minor injuries came next at 39%.

Location of Offense



Twenty-one percent (21%) of the Aggravated Assault incidents occurred at the location "Highway/Road/Alley" according to the law enforcement agencies that reported their crime data to the Michigan Incident Crime Reporting System.
