

Sexual Penetration-Penis/Vagina



DEFINITION

Criminal Sexual Conduct (CSC) 1st Degree (MCL 750.520b) is the sexual intercourse of a person, forcibly and/or against that person's will; or, not forcibly or against the person's will where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of his/her temporary or permanent mental or physical incapacity. Michigan collects the crime data for this offense based on the Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Incident Based Reporting System (NIBRS).

Note: CSC 1st and 3rd are differentiated by the weapon involved and the degree of the victim injury.

ANALYSIS

VOLUME

The number of victims reported for CSC - 1st Degree, Sexual Penetration - Penis/Vagina was 3,016. This is a reported decrease of seven percent from 2013 and a 14 percent decrease from 2010.

More victims were reported in the month of August than any other month. The fewest number of victims were reported in December.

RATE

The crime rate for this offense in 2014 was 30 for every 100,000 persons. In 2013, the crime rate was 33 for every 100,000 persons, a decrease of nine percent.

CLEARANCES

Law enforcement agencies cleared 802 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance. This is a reported 28 percent clearance rate, which is a two percent improvement from 2013.


VICTIM INFORMATION

Most of the victims (77 percent) did not receive any injury. There were 16 percent of victims who received Apparent Minor injuries and five percent received Possible Internal injuries.


Over 36 percent of the victims had a Personal Weapon such as hands, fists, feet, etc., used against them. Fifty-three (53) percent of the victims did not have a weapon used against them.

When reviewing the Victim to Offender relationships, 22 percent of the time the victim was an Acquaintance of the offender. With 14 percent of the victims, the Victim to Offender relationship was not known to law enforcement, 11 percent were Strangers or Otherwise Known, and nine percent were the Child of the Offender.

Victims by Month




Victims by Day






Weapon Used Against Victim

Michigan collects the crime data for this offense based on the Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Incident Based Reporting System (NIBRS).

Note: CSC 1st and 3rd are differentiated by the weapon involved and the degree of the victim injury.

ANALYSIS

VOLUME

The number of victims reported for CSC - 3rd Degree, Sexual Penetration - Penis/Vagina was 1,013. This is a reported decrease of nine percent from 2013.

More victims were reported in the month of October than any other month. The fewest number of victims was reported in December. The most victims were reported on Wednesdays.

RATE

The crime rate for this offense in 2014 was 10 for every 100,000 persons, which is a reported decrease of nine percent from 2013.

CLEARANCES

Law enforcement agencies cleared 310 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance out of the 975 incidents that were reported. This is a reported 32 percent clearance rate.

VICTIM INFORMATION


Most of the victims (84 percent) did not receive any injury. There were 12 percent of victims who received Apparent Minor Injuries and three percent received Possible Internal injuries.

Sixty (60) percent of the victims did not have a weapon used against them. The most used weapon occurring 35 percent of the time was a Personal Weapon meaning hands, fists, feet, etc.



Victims by Month










Sexual Penetration-Penis/Vagina



Victim Injury















Weapon Used Against Victim

ANALYSIS

VOLUME

The number of victims reported for CSC - 1st Degree, Sexual Penetration - Oral/Anal was 1,040. This is a reported decrease of five percent from 2013.

More victims were reported in the months of January than any other month. The fewest number of victims was reported in December. The most victims were reported on Thursdays.

RATE

The crime rate for this offense in 2014 was 10 for every 100,000 persons, which is a reported decrease of nine percent from 2013.

CLEARANCES

Law enforcement agencies cleared 230 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance out of the 911 incidents that were reported. This is a reported 25 percent clearance rate.





Victims by Month









Sexual Penetration-Oral/Anal










Michigan collects the crime data for this offense based on the Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Incident Based Reporting System (NIBRS).

Note: CSC 1st and 3rd are differentiated by the weapon involved and the degree of the victim injury.

ANALYSIS

VOLUME

The number of victims reported for CSC - 3rd Degree, Sexual Penetration -Oral/Anal was 420. This is a reported decrease of 11 percent from 2013.

More victims were reported in the month of October than any other month. The fewest number of victims was reported in February and April. These crimes occurred most often on Wednesdays.

RATE

The crime rate for this offense in 2014 was four for every 100,000 persons, which is a reported decrease of 20 percent from 2013.

CLEARANCES

Law enforcement agencies cleared 103 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance out of the 388 incidents that were reported. This is a reported 26 percent clearance rate.





The most reported location was a Residence/Home, which equates to 66 percent of the victims. The next highest percentage was a School-Elementary/Secondary location at five percent.



VOLUME

The number of victims reported for CSC - 1st Degree, Sexual Penetration - Object was 345. This is a reported decrease of four percent from 2013.

More victims were reported in the month of October than any other month. The fewest number of victims was reported in May and November. Most of these crimes occurred on Fridays.

RATE

The crime rate for this offense in 2014 was three for every 100,000 persons, which is a reported decrease of 25 percent from 2013.

CLEARANCES

Law enforcement agencies cleared 67 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance out of the 314 incidents that were reported. This is a reported 21 percent clearance rate.



Law enforcement agencies cleared 47 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance out of the 152 incidents that were reported. This is a reported 31 percent clearance rate.






Victims by Month

Victim Injury




Location of Crime






