

Bus Inspection Report to the Michigan Legislature School Year 2010-2011

This report is published in accordance with the Michigan Department of State Police appropriation of Public Act 63 Article XVI of 2011. Section 220 of Part 2 “General Provisions” mandates an annual report to the House and Senate Appropriations Subcommittees, regarding the inspections conducted under Sections 257.715a and 257.1839.

The Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Division (CVED) conducts the annual inspection requirements in accordance with the school year calendar, September 1 through August 31; therefore, this report is being submitted for the school year of September 1, 2010 through August 31, 2011.

Definitions:

- Passed Inspection means the bus was found to have no defects the first time it was inspected during that school year.
- Red-Tagged means a bus that was found to have a defect that prevented the bus from being used to transport pupils to and from school and school-related events until repairs were made.
- Yellow-Tagged means a bus that was found to have a defect that required repairs to be made within 60 days, but still could be used to transport pupils to and from school and school-related events.
