WHO NEEDS TRAINING?

Agency authorized recipients who request individuals to complete a fingerprint-based Criminal History Record Information (CHRI) background check and receives CHRI results for the purpose of employment or volunteer placement.

Such as:

- A Public School/Intermediate School District
- Academy/Charter school
- Non-public/Private school

INTERESTED IN HOSTING? KNOW SOMEONE WHO IS?

This training is to provide information on applicable federal and state laws, regulations, and policies, necessary to ensure the security, confidentiality, and integrity of CHRI.

Option 1

- In person at your agency venue
- Requires a minimum audience of 20 persons
- Takes up to four hours
- Includes two 15 minute breaks; or one half hour break

Option 2

- Via webinar
- Requires a minimum of four participants
- Takes up to four hours
- Includes two 15 minute breaks; or one half hour break
