Letters of Interest: Questions & Answers

Question:

When are the letters of interest due?

Answer:

All letters of interest must be received by close of business Thursday September 3rd, 2009

Question:

Can we purchase in-car computers for this project?

Answer:

Yes, in-car computers or (MDCs) can be requested as part of your letter of interest.

Question:

Is there a sample or standard 'letter of interest' format that we should use?

Answer:

No, there is not a sample or standard 'letter of interest' format that should be used. Just remember to include all of the information being requested in the 'scoring' section.

Question:

We already have enough hardware and software to collect and submit crashes electronically, can we request funds for training?

Answer:

Yes, you can request funds to pay for the training portion of the project

Question:

We were recently awarded a grant to implement a countywide records management and mobile field reporting system, including crash. We are in need of additional funds to complete this project. Can we apply to you for this supplemental funding?

Answer:

Yes, you can request funds to pay for the costs of the **crash** portion of this project

Question:

Which vendor is the best?

Answer:

Any of the vendors that are approved by the state can provide the necessary information for you to complete and submit a letter of interest.

Question:

Can we continue to use Trackview to scan our UD-10's?

Answer:

Yes.
