Authority

- Delegate Practice
- Licensed health professional or EMS personnel who has the most training specific to the provision of emergency medical care.
- If HCP or EMS is not available, the authority is vested in the most appropriately trained representative of a public safety agency at the scene of the emergency.

- **MFR – EMR**
 - Emergency Medical Responder
- **EMT**
- **EMT-S – AEMT**
 - Advanced Emergency Medical Technician
- **Paramedic**

EMMS

Proposed National Changes In Care

- MFR/EMR – No Spinal Precautions
- EMT – No Advanced Airway (ETDLA)
- EMT-S/AEMT – No Advanced Airway (ET)
 - Add minimal pharmacological intervention
- Paramedic – No Appreciable Changes
