Pursuant to Section 703(8) of Public Act 84 of 2015, Article XVI, the Michigan Department of State Police reports a total of **\$2,575,979** was expended from the Disaster and Emergency Contingency Fund in Fiscal Year 2015 in accordance with Sections 18 and 19 of the Emergency Management Act, 1976 PA 390.

August 2014 SE Michigan Flooding – Sec. 18 State Agency Expenses	\$51,514
Costs for providing disaster response support services, including flood cleanup kits.	
August 2015 NW Michigan Storms – Sec. 18 State Agency Expenses	\$33,889
Costs for providing disaster response and support services during the severe storms that occurred in Grand Traverse and Leelanau counties.	
Spring 2014 Northern Michigan Flooding – Sec. 19 Assistance to Local Units	\$770,905
Reimbursement payments to local units of government for eligible costs incurred from the severe storms and subsequent flooding.	
Winter 2013-14 Deep Freeze – Sec. 19 Assistance to Local Units	\$1,719,671
Reimbursement payments made to local units of government in the Upper Peninsula and Northern Lower Peninsula for eligible costs.
