

# IED RESPONSE ON MASS TRANSIT AND PASSENGER RAIL SYSTEMS

## Course Description

This course, approved by FEMA, provides an environment for first responders to perform tactical operations in a scenario-driven exercise. The course features realistic conditions involving a post-blast IED incident on a mass transit/passenger rail system. Training includes classroom presentations, hands-on performance based training, and a full-scale realistic exercise at the Center for National Response (CNR ) Memorial Tunnel in Gallagher, West Virginia.

## Course Objectives

- Develop and execute an Incident Action Plan (IAP) and direct and coordinate explosive device response operations
- Conduct search and on-site assessment, public safety and security response operations, traffic, crowd, and scene control operations, law enforcement operations, and fire operations assessments
- Conduct public information, alert/warning, and notification operations
- Conduct triage and pre-hospital operations, develop a medical transportation plan
- Develop evacuation plans as applicable to event
- Demobilize the on-site incident command

## Target Audience

This three-day course will target audience including emergency medical services, fire services, hazardous materials, and law enforcement.

## CEU's

Students will receive 2.8 CEU's at the completion of the course.

## Required Prerequisites

Successful completion of the following ICS courses are IS-100, 200, 300, 700, and 800.
