

Join us for a fun and educational glimpse of by-gone days of the Petoskey area as it was in the Hemingway era.

We'll gather in the resort lobby at 9:30 AM. Our first stop will be at the Little Traverse Historical Museum and/or Gas light District. Cost of entry to the museum is just \$2.00 which is located in the railroad station near the marina. The station was converted into a museum in the 1960's and houses a permanent exhibit and mementos of the Ernest Hemingway family. For the shoppers of the group it is conveniently located near the tunnel leading to the famous "Gas Light" historical shopping district.

The City Park Grill will accommodate us for lunch at 11:45. This Petoskey landmark was constructed in 1879. Rumors persist that Hemingway enjoyed playing billiards here. The massive mahogany Brunswick bar is spectacular. Lunch cost is on your own.

Following lunch we will meet on the Terrace Inn porch in the renowned Bay View settlement. A guide will lead us on a historical walking tour while sharing stories and noting architectural points of interest among the over 400 public buildings and Victorian "Cottages" of Bay View!
