

MSPYLA STUDENT RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Students shall abide by all instruction given by the school commander or by his/her designee.
2. Students attending MSPYLA must be 15 years of age by June 15, 2014 and not older than 16 years of age by August 29, 2014. Applicants who do not meet this age requirement **WILL NOT** be permitted to attend MSPYLA.
3. All students will rise at 5:30 a. m. and prepare for physical training.
4. Sleeping quarters shall be kept in regulation manner at all times as instructed by the school commander or by his/her designee. All students will report to their sleeping quarters no later than 9:30 p.m. each night. Lights out at 10:00 p.m. **Dormitory room doors shall remain open and unlocked at all times.**
5. Males will be clean shaven at all times. Females will not wear make-up or nail polish, except for during MSPLYA graduation day. All participants will wear their hair above the collar. Ponytails shall not hang loose but can be braided or secured to the head with elastic bands.
6. Jewelry of any kind, wrist bands or watches are not permitted to be worn at any time unless authorized by the school commander.
7. Obscenities, use of profanity, negative gestures, and/or posturing are prohibited at all times.
8. Students shall not engage in mischievous behavior of any kind. Students engaging in mischievous behavior shall be dismissed from the program.
9. Students shall not have physical contact with other students or staff at any time. Students engaging in physical contact shall be dismissed from the program.
10. Students shall contact a member of the school staff if an accident or illness occurs.
11. **All injuries and illnesses must be reported as soon as detected.**
12. All electronic devices, including, but not limited to: cellular phones, MP3 players, video games, computer devices, are prohibited unless authorized by the school commander.
13. Newspapers, magazines, books, and musical instruments are prohibited unless authorized by the school commander.
14. Only medication prescribed by the student's physician will be permitted. Medication must be enclosed in the original prescribed packaging clearly stating the student's name, physician's name, and pharmacy name. **Over-the-counter medications will be provided to students by the school commander or designee if necessary.** Prescribed medication shall be taken by the student in the recommended dosage unit prescribed by the student's physician and/or by what dosage units are indicated on the prescribed medication packaging label. Failure to take prescribed medication shall result in dismissal from the program.
15. The training tank and sporting equipment will not be used unless authorized by the school commander or by his/her designee.
16. Except during regular class instruction time or when on special assignment, students shall stay in assigned areas.

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17. Incoming calls must be of an emergency nature. *A member of the school staff should be notified of any emergency arising at home.
18. Students will have no visitors unless a member of the school staff gives permission.
19. There will be no passes or time off to any student except by approval of the school commander or by his/her designee.
20. If for any reason a student wishes to leave the school, he/she shall immediately notify a member of the school staff.
21. The rules of occupancy of the Michigan State Police Training Academy, which are posted, shall apply to all students enrolled in the school.
22. Pop/candy machines are OFF LIMITS. Eating candy, chewing gum, and use of tobacco are prohibited.
23. All verbal orders and directives issued by a member of the staff or guest will be immediately complied with.
