Best Practices

- *M-29 Bike lanes on Shoulders*- discussion on when is it a shoulder and when it is a bike lane. MDOT working on definitions of different types of bike lanes and where they are.

Awareness / Education

- *LMB Share Mi Roads* - promotion of new website that will be linking to national research;
- Detroit Greenways Coalition Education Committee – NEW; trying to get education information out there, still developing;
- Grand Rapids is starting a bicycle Safety campaign - They are making it reproducible, Continue to monitor
- Ann Arbor Ped Safety Action Plan – The City of Ann Arbor has been acting to conduct a scientific understanding of non-motorized safety. SEMCOG is taking an advisory role for the city.
