

**BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (BYRNE JAG) AWARDS
NORTHERN MICHIGAN
FISCAL YEAR 2016**

- County of Cheboygan - 53rd Circuit Court, Family Division - has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$80,000 for Juvenile-Focused Community Policing.
Summary: The 53rd Circuit Court, Family Division, SAYPA, and juvenile probation provides youth with 24/7 support, supervision, education, tools, and empathy, to assist each youth in overcoming their individual issues so they can remain in their communities. This grant will utilize combined resources from the 53rd Circuit Court, Cheboygan County Sheriff's Department's liaison officer and a Michigan State Police community services trooper.
- Michigan Department of State Police - S.S.C.E.N.T. has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$71,000 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.
Summary: The State, Sheriffs, Chiefs Enforcement of Narcotics Team (S.S.C.E.N.T.) is a multijurisdictional task force that integrates state, county, and local law enforcement resources to target drug dealers and conspiracies, eliminate drug availability and usage, and ends violence associated with drug trafficking.
- County of Missaukee - T.N.T. has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$97,000 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.
Summary: The Traverse Narcotic Team (T.N.T.) is a multijurisdictional narcotics task force operating in eight counties in the northwestern portion of the lower peninsula of Michigan. T.N.T. provides investigative services for all police agencies in the eight-county area. The team specializes in investigating narcotics violators and other illegal activities through investigative means, surveillance, and undercover work.
- County of Alpena - H.U.N.T. has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$84,000 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.
Summary: The Huron Undercover Narcotics Team (H.U.N.T.) is a multijurisdictional task force dedicated to the reduction of narcotics crime and providing general detective support to other law enforcement agencies. H.U.N.T. achieves this through proactive policing strategies and collaborative law enforcement operations. H.U.N.T. also conducts public awareness/training campaigns.
- Michigan Department of State Police - S.T.I.N.G. has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$71,000 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.
Summary: Funding for the Strike Team Investigative Narcotics Group (S.T.I.N.G.) will be used to conduct undercover criminal investigations in six counties. S.T.I.N.G. will collaborate with all area agencies to investigate criminals who operate both within and across jurisdictional boundaries.
- County of Emmet - S.A.N.E. has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$74,000 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.
Summary: The Straits Area Narcotics Enforcement (S.A.N.E.) is a multijurisdictional task force comprised of six sworn officers and two administrative assistants. S.A.N.E. identifies trends of illegal drug use and sales, identifies traffickers, trafficking organizations, and suspects involved in drug-related crime and develops criminal cases on these persons.
