Task Force Continues to Investigate Leads in Roadway Shootings

WIXOM, MI. Since the multijurisdictional task force was established on Oct. 19, 2012, over 2,200 tips have been submitted to law enforcement, and investigators continue to actively pursue leads. Of these tips, approximately 1,300 came in after the FBI and ATF increased the reward.

Investigators have interviewed numerous people and investigated numerous tips.

Law enforcement continues to solicit information about a dark-colored car and a suspect matching the previously released suspect sketch based on a witness account. The task force encourages citizens to remain vigilant in reporting information leading to potential suspects, as it is our belief that the public will lead us to this individual.

Anonymous tips can be reported to 1-800-SPEAK-UP. Tips can also be reported to any police agency; there is a \$102,000 reward for information leading to an arrest and conviction.

Contrary to some media reports, only three of the 24 reported incidents have occurred on I-96. The remaining incidents occurred on trunk lines and local streets. The following agencies have received reports of shooting incidents:

Wixom Police Department – 10 incidents
Ingham County Sheriff's Office – 8 incidents
Oakland County Sheriff's Office – 2 incidents
Livingston County Sheriff's Office – 3 incidents
Shiawassee County Sheriff's Office – 1 incident

There are numerous federal, state, county and local agencies assisting in this multijurisdictional investigation.
