

**BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (BYRNE JAG) AWARDS &
RESIDENTIAL SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT (RSAT) AWARDS

FISCAL YEAR 2014**

- Michigan Department of State Police - D.R.A.N.O. has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$95,400 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.
Summary: The Downriver Area Narcotics Organization (D.R.A.N.O.) is a multijurisdictional drug enforcement task force which targets narcotics violators in the Downriver area and surrounding source cities. The task force works with state, local, and federal law enforcement agencies to identify, disrupt, and dismantle drug trafficking organizations.
- Michigan Department of State Police - C.O.M.E.T. has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$125,929 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.
Summary: The County of Macomb Enforcement Team (C.O.M.E.T.) is a multijurisdictional task force which started in 1982 and is made up of federal, state, county, and local police officers. The team's primary function is to enforce narcotics laws, apprehend violent criminals, and support other criminal justice agencies. C.O.M.E.T. primarily serves the Macomb County area.
- County of Oakland - N.E.T. has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$154,758 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.
Summary: The Oakland County Narcotic Enforcement Team (N.E.T.) is a multijurisdictional task force created to encourage cooperation between law enforcement departments and federal agencies operating in southeast Michigan. N.E.T. works cooperatively in an effort to apprehend and convict those involved in the use, sale, and distribution of illegal drugs and narcotics.
- Michigan Department of State Police - W.W.N. has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$82,664 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.
Summary: The Western Wayne Criminal Investigations (W.W.N.) leverages state, local, and federal resources to disrupt and dismantle drug trafficking organizations and combat drug crimes and associated violent criminal activity. W.W.N. is focused on removing multijurisdictional offenders and conspirators from Western Wayne County.
- Michigan Department of State Police - L.A.W.N.E.T. has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$96,695 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.
Summary: The Livingston and Washtenaw Narcotics Enforcement Team (L.A.W.N.E.T.) is a multijurisdictional drug enforcement task force with full-time narcotics enforcement and auto theft-related responsibilities for Livingston and Washtenaw Counties.
- Michigan Department of State Police - R.H.I.N.O. has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$38,959 for Multijurisdictional Task Forces.
Summary: The Region of Irish Hills Narcotics Office (R.H.I.N.O.) is responsible for investigating narcotics-related complaints and targets mid- to high-level drug dealers in Lenawee and Hillsdale Counties. The team partners with local agencies and assists with investigations of all types of crimes. R.H.I.N.O. participates in drug abuse prevention with the probate courts and local/intermediate school districts.
- City of Detroit - Detroit Police Department has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$9,690 for School Safety.
Summary: The Detroit Police Department will partner with the Fisher Magnet Upper School to reduce crime and increase prosecution on its school campus. This program will provide an upgrade to the main parking lot with a purchase of an electronic security gate.

- City of Morenci - Morenci Police Department has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$19,200 for School Safety.
Summary: The Morenci Police Department will partner with the Morenci Area Schools to implement a video surveillance system that will enhance the ability to provide early warning to threats, deter potential threats, and provide documentation and evidence when crime occurs.
- Township of Canton - Canton Township Police Department has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$20,000 for School Safety.
Summary: The Canton Police Department will partner with the Plymouth-Canton Community Schools to improve school safety through the installation of a lockdown notification system. This system can be activated by a pull station and will emit an audible alert signaling a lockdown.
- City of Troy - Troy Police Department has been awarded Byrne JAG funds in the amount of \$10,000 for School Safety.
Summary: The Troy Police Department will partner with Troy School District by purchasing emergency and visitor signage for its school buildings. The signage will allow first responders to immediately recognize the locations of emergency entrances and, during normal school hours, will notify visitors of acceptable access points.
- County of St. Clair - St. Clair County Sheriff's Dept has been awarded RSAT funds in the amount of \$59,000 for Residential Substance Abuse Treatment.
Summary: St. Clair County proposes to provide an intensive cognitive behavioral treatment program addressing the substance abuse and criminal thinking of felony offenders during their incarceration at the county jail. The three phases of the program are Intensive Education, Therapeutic Groups and Re-Entry Case Management.
