

10.0 SAMPLE STOLEN PROPERTY AGREEMENT

BIG CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT

STOLEN PROPERTY AGREEMENT

PREAMBLE: In an effort to effect crime prevention, recover stolen property and promote citizen-police cooperation, the Big City Police Department may advise individuals or businesses of the status of serialized property on file in the LEIN and NCIC computers. After this agreement has been executed and is on file, a known representative of the signatory may inquire of this department as to the status of serialized property, pursuant to the terms of this agreement.

TERMS: The Big City Police Department will check serialized property if the property is in the possession of the individual, and the property can and will be immediately turned over to the police if found to be stolen. The representative of the business wishing to have a given serialized item or property checked should appear in person at the Big City Police Department, identify himself and inform the department that this agreement is on file. An inquiry made that results in a determination that the property is stolen, will result in police being dispatched and an investigation initiated.

CAVEAT: A negative response from the inquiry is not positive fact that the serialized property is not stolen as an owner of a stolen item may not know the serial number to enter into the files, or the item may not yet be reported stolen. It is to be further noted and understood that under Michigan Law, ownership and possession remains with the lawful owner. This Agreement should be reviewed periodically for timeliness.
