Messages

1. Once the record is transmitted, an initial check of the following fields occur:
 - a) TCN (Transaction Control Number)
 - b) Name (valid format)
 - c) Race (is valid)
 - d) Sex (is valid)
 - e) Date of Birth (is valid and greater than 7 yr.)
 - f) Fingerprints (in correct sequence)
2. If these fields are ACCURATE, the record is ACCEPTED for processing.
3. If one of these fields is INCORRECT, the record is REJECTED and an ERROR MESSAGE is sent back to Live Scan noting the problem.
4. If the record is REJECTED, the OPERATOR should correct the problem and RE-TRANSMIT.
5. A record will also reject a DUPLICATE TCN (i.e., the record was transmitted twice) even if the retention code was changed from one transmission to another. If a fingerprint record is sent for QUICK ID and is later determined that arrest charges are reportable, a new record and fingerprints must be transmitted with a retention code of "Y". This will create a new TCN.

NOTE: This message is **NOT A RESPONSE**, it only notifies the operator if a record was accepted or rejected.

TRANSACTIONS TYPES

- ❖ **Michigan CAR – ID Only (CAR-ID)**: Use this transaction when you need to identify a subject by fingerprints and **do not** want to do an arrest build. This transaction may be used for bench warrants (where original arrest was already built), probation violations, and failure to appear (only if you need to identify subject by fingerprints). If you have a subject who will not give their name or date of birth (dob) all you have to do is make up a name and dob, fill in the rest of the required fields, take the prints and send. You will then conduct a search (by fingerprints) and if this subject is known (through previous arrests) we will return the rap sheet on that subject. Example: male with no ID and will not cooperate, do an ID Only, under name put John Doe, dob pick 1-1-1970, unknown race, male, put in rest of physical descriptors, take prints and submit. If MSP/FBI has an arrest record on subject it will be returned via LEIN for that transaction control number.
- ❖ **Michigan CAR – Arrest Build (CAR)**: Use this transaction when you want to build a criminal history (arrest record) on a subject while conducting a fingerprint search to verify identity. This transaction requires demographics, arrest data along with fingerprints.
- ❖ **Michigan/Miscellaneous Applicant – Applicant Build (MAP)**: This type of fingerprint transaction can only be done if there is a corresponding state or federal statute requiring it. Choose this transaction when running an applicant transaction such as a CCW, school teacher or criminal justice employment. The criminal being the only free of charge applicant transaction. This type of transaction requires you to fill in the A/O/N field. A are for agencies pre-registered with us that have been given an agency identifier number. O is for ORI assigned, which designates the response will be returned to an ORI #. Refer to the Fingerprint Reason Code Table that follows for choosing the correct A/O/N field.

A. MICHIGAN CAR – ID ONLY OR SUBJECT IDENTIFICATION (CAR-ID)

Retention Code. This is an alpha field indicating whether the arrest or applicant information submitted is to be retained in the Michigan AFIS and Criminal History Record System. An “N” is for identification only.

Name. This alpha-special field contains the name(s) of the subject. The format shall be the surname followed by a comma (,) followed by the given name(s), which are separated by a space. Hyphens, commas, and blanks are allowed as special characters. Hyphens are used only once in the last name. Additional last names can be entered under Alias Names. When a subject has more than one middle name, run them together with no blanks.

Aliases. This field contains alias names of the subject. The format is the same as described in the NAME field and the same 30-character limit applies to the field length. Up to ten aliases may be provided, duplicates are not allowed.

Sex. This field is used to report the gender of the subject. F (female), M (male), U (unknown). In the case of a transvestite or male/female impersonator, enter U for unknown.

Race. This field is used to indicate the race of the subject. Use the predominant race code from the following table:

- A** Chinese, Japanese, Filipino, Korean, Polynesian, Indian, Indonesian, Asian Indian, Samoan, or any other Pacific Islander
- B** A person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa
- I** American Indian, Eskimo, or Alaskan native, or a person having origins in any of the 48 contiguous states of the United States or Alaska who maintains cultural identification through tribal affiliation or community recognition
- M** Middle Eastern
- U** Of indeterminable race
- W** Caucasian, Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American, or other Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race

Eye Color. In this field, use one of the codes below to indicate the subject's eye color:

- Black - BLK
- Blue - BLU
- Brown - BRO
- Gray - GRY
- Green - GRN
- Hazel - HAZ
- Maroon - MAR
- Multicolored - MUL
- Pink - PNK
- Unknown - XXX

Hair Color. In this field, use one of the codes below to indicate the subject's hair color.

- Bald – BAL
- Black – BLK
- Blond or Strawberry – BLN
- Blue – BLU
- Brown – BRO
- Gray or Partially Gray – GRY
- Green – GRN
- Orange – ONG
- Pink – PNK
- Red or Auburn – RED
- Sandy – SDY
- White – WHI
- Unknown – XXX

Height. This field contains the subject's height as a three-character value. If reported in feet and inches, the first (leftmost) digit is used to show feet, while the two rightmost digits are used to show inches between 00 and 11. If reported in inches, the leftmost character is "N" followed by two digits. If height is unknown, 000 is entered. The allowable range is 400 to 711. Heights outside this range will be clamped at these limits.

Weight. In this field, the subject's weight in pounds is entered. If weight is unknown, 000 is entered. All weights in excess of 499 pounds will be set to 499 lbs. WGT must be in the range 050 to 499 lbs., however, there is no minimum range limit for missing persons or unknown persons.

Date of Birth. This field contains the date of birth. It is entered as an eight-digit number in the same format as specified in Section 1.2 of this appendix. If dob is completely unknown, enter as 01011970. Partial dobs are not allowed.

Social Security Number. This field contains the subject's social security number, if known. This number shall be entered as nine consecutive digits with no embedded punctuation characters. No foreign social security numbers shall be used.

State ID Number. Leave blank.

Driver's License State. This field is a two-character code identifying the state where the driver's license was obtained. Data within this field is a two-character alpha code that identifies the state that issued the license. The code is obtained from the NCIC table of valid state codes (see State & Country Codes Section). If the driver's license number is entered, the driver's license state is mandatory.

Driver's License Number. The driver's license number cannot be longer than 20 characters, and must contain at least one number (all alpha is not allowed). Any character, such as a hyphen, may be used to break up the number on the graphic interface (GUI), but these characters will not be included in the NIST file. When a Michigan license is entered, it must consist of one alpha character followed by 12 numbers, and the first three numbers must be "000" or between "100 and 666" (with no digit greater than 6), or between 726 and 730.

Example: 051 – not valid
689 – not valid
721 – not valid

If the driver's license state is entered then the driver's license number is mandatory.

FBI Number. Leave blank.

Residence of Person Fingerprinted. The subject's residential address may be entered in this field as alphanumeric data. It is mandatory that a comma be entered after the street address, city, and state.

Vendors are required to break this field into sub-fields on the GUI. They must combine the sub-fields into the NIST standard field RES (2.041) with the commas included between sub-fields. Blank sub-fields are not valid. User entered commas in sub-fields are not allowed. Maximum length of this field, including commas, is 120 characters. Vendors are required to trim multiple spaces from the sub-fields when concatenating. Single spaces are not acceptable.

Example of RES field after concatenating:

Acceptable: 7150 Harris Drive,Lansing,MI48913
Unacceptable: 7150 Harris Drive , Lansing , MI, 48913

The length of the sub-fields will be up to:

Scars, Marks and Tattoos. For each scar, mark, or tattoo present on the subject, the appropriate NCIC code shall be used in this information item. Blanks are allowed as special characters. **Note: Refer to list toward back of guide.**

Miscellaneous Identification Number. If there are any miscellaneous identification numbers, they shall be entered in this field. The format of the data shall be a two-letter identifying code, followed by a hyphen (-), followed by the number itself. The following table lists the acceptable two letter identifying codes. Interspersed blanks are invalid. Types of numbers not listed in the following table (such as driver's license) shall not be entered. Only U.S. Passport numbers shall be entered; foreign numbers shall be ignored. The size of the MNU is limited to 15 characters. As many as four miscellaneous numbers may be included in this field. Each MNU shall be separated from the next by the (R_s) separated character. No duplicates are allowed.

When processing CWR (Concealed Weapons Renewal) fingerprints, select CW in the MNU field. Then enter the license number as it appears on the current CCW license. Do not enter any other license ID when the selection is CW.

Identification Comment. Data in this field is free text data up to 50 characters. Additional miscellaneous identification remarks may be entered in the field. The first character may not be a blank.

Prison Number. Leave blank.

Send Copy To. The purpose of this field is to indicate requirements for production of additional response(s) for a receiving agency other than the contributor. It shall contain the NCIC assigned originating agency identifiers (ORI's) for agencies who receive a copy of the response. Each ORI consists of nine bytes of alphanumeric data. Use this field to send a copy of the State/FBI results to another law enforcement agency. The submitting agency will still receive a copy. This can be used to send prosecutors/courts copies of the CHR rap sheet.

Date of Arrest. This field contains the date of arrest. The date shall appear as an eight digit number in the same format as specified for CDD.

This concludes all the data for submitting an ID only search. Proceed to capturing the fingerprints and submit the transaction.

B. Michigan CAR – Arrest Build

Retention Code. This is an alpha field indicating whether the arrest or applicant information submitted is to be retained in the Michigan AFIS and Criminal History Record System. “Y” indicates retention code yes and must be accompanied by arrest information in order to build a criminal history record on subject.

Demographics. Refer to ID only for proper entry of these fields.

Arrest Segment

Incident/Complaint/OCA #. This is the arresting agency’s complaint number (minimum one number with maximum of 12 alphanumeric characters). Not allowed are “none”, “unknown”, “unk”, “n/a” or “msp”. The prosecutor links their charge segment to the arrest segment using the TCN/OCA #. It is imperative that a valid number be entered at the time of arrest. If you have more than one complaint number, it is very important that you **add** the second complaint number with the corresponding arrest disposition code, date of offense, counts, and charge type codes. This will create a separate incident on CHR so that the prosecutor will be able to report more than one CTN number.

Arrest Disposition Code. Total of five codes - REW, CHG, REP, JUV, and NTA. Using Live Scan you have the ability to do an arrest as one code, add another incident, and pick a totally different arrest disposition code with the corresponding arrest information for the separate charge.

REW – Used on a new adult arrest. This arrest code signifies that the prosecutor has not yet issued a warrant with a CTN # and PACC code. Any of the three charge type codes (CTC) may be used for this type of arrest. It is suggested for use on all adults regardless of a warrant arrest or not. If your department decides to use this code on a warrant arrest, you have to notify the prosecutor’s office and they will still have to report their charge data to CHR.

CHG – Warrant arrest. The prosecutor has already issued a CTN # and PACC code. Using this type of arrest code requires you to enter a valid CTN # on the arrest screen and also a PACC code in the charge type code field. If you are processing a warrant arrest but do not have both of these numbers, do as a REW arrest and leave the CTN # field blank.

REP – Same as REW but for a juvenile.

JUV – Same as CHG but for a juvenile.

NTA – This is to be used on **ordinance violations**. Pick NTA, then pick “O” for ordinance in the arrest flag type. Not only is the prosecutor ORI field not mandatory, it is not wanted because the city attorney does not report to CHR, only the county prosecutor does, so this field is now left blank.

Date of Offense. This could differ from the date of arrest and is an eight digit number.

Counts. This is the number of charge counts, not to be confused with arrest #1 – B & E, #2 – Traffic. It is how many B & E’s, how many Traffic’s, (i.e.; 3 counts of B & E, 5 counts Traffic, 20 counts Assault). So, if you have 20 counts of Assault, you just enter 20 in charge count and then enter Assault.

Charge Type Code. Three types, Michigan Arrest Code - MAC (previously and incorrectly referred to as MICR), PACC code, and Arrest File Class – AFC. You must chose one of the three options (with CHG and JUV you are restricted to using only PACC code) and then in the next field pick the corresponding number to go with that charge type code. NOTE – CHR converts everything to Arrest File Class regardless of which of the three you chose.

MAC/PACC/File Class. This is the corresponding number to go with the charge type code picked.

General Offense Code. Three codes, A – Attempt, C – Conspiracy, S – Solicit. **This is not a mandatory field.**

Warrant Holding/Arrest ORI #. Nine character Michigan originating requestor identifier (ORI). Your Live Scan can build an arrest for any agency in Michigan that has arrest powers but shall be done only with your consent at their request. Remember you only build arrests on your warrants, so if you pick someone up on another agency’s warrant, you have the option of running an **ID only** transaction on subject to identify – **do not** initiate a record build for the other agency’s warrant.

Prosecutor ORI #. Nine character Michigan agency identifier. It is mandatory unless Arrest Disposition Code is NTA, then it is not used. When it is a juvenile, make sure to put in a family/probate court.

Court ORI #. Nine character Michigan agency identifier. It is important when processing juvenile arrests that you pick a family/probate court.

C. Michigan/Miscellaneous Applicant – Applicant Build (MAP)

Demographics. Refer to ID only for proper entry of these fields.

Fingerprint Reason. A two or three letter code indicating the reason the fingerprints are being searched. See appendix for a list of the codes along with RQID Identifier and the associated costs of each.

RQID (Type or Identifier). Consists of three codes. A = Agency Identifier, O = Originating Agency Identifier, N – Print card only.

Requestor ID Number. If RQID Type or Identifier is an “A” this will be a nine digit number assigned by MSP-CRD and given to the agency authorized to do fingerprint searches (If your Live Scan device does not prefill the field with leading zeros then you must do it yourself. If it is an “O” it will be the nine digit ORI number assigned to the law enforcement agency authorized to receive those responses. “N” is for print only (which simply means print out a fingerprint card, do not send transaction to the state.

Retention Code. This is an alpha field indicating whether the arrest or applicant information submitted is to be retained in the Michigan AFIS and Criminal History Record System. Currently, all applicants are changed by the Criminal Records Division (CRD) automatically to “Y” retain.

Demographics. Refer to ID only for proper entry of these fields.

Fingerprint Reason. A two/three digit code is chosen to correspond to the applicant fingerprint reason (See table below).

Also, any costs associated with the fingerprints will appear below in the chart. There are still ten fingerprint reasons that require that the fingerprints be mailed as they require additional paperwork along with fingerprints.

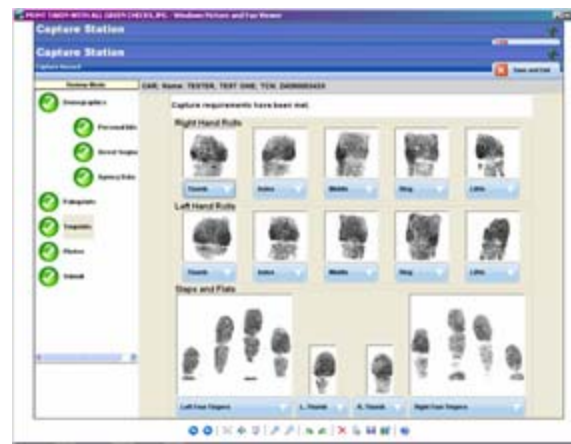

FINGERPRINTS

Fingerprints are broken into two categories, slap impressions and rolled impressions. Most Live Scan devices require the operator to take the slap images first followed by the rolled impressions. Also, Live Scan devices will do a sequence check from the slaps against the rolled prints to verify they are taken in the correct order. Right, left four finger slaps exclude the thumbs which are done separately. When taking rolled impressions try to get 2-4 lines beneath the break of the finger. When taking the four finger slap try to not slant the fingers as this could cause sequence errors throughout the rolled impressions. Rolled impressions should be taken from nail to nail, straight up and down, giving AFIS and latent examiners more surface area to compare.

PALM PRINTS

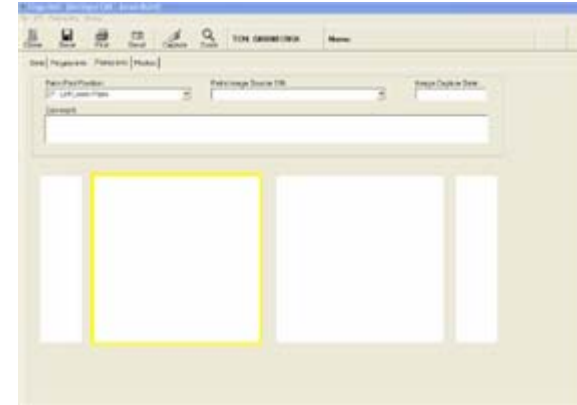
Palm prints are optional when doing a criminal record build Live Scan transaction. Several Live Scan devices break the palm print down into upper and lower palms while a few just capture one palm print. Included with the palm prints should be the writer's palms, both left and right. When taking the lower palm, many times you need to use a small amount of pressure on the back of the subject's hand so the cup part of the palm begins to appear on the screen while verifying that you are not pressing so hard as to degrade the rest of the palm print.

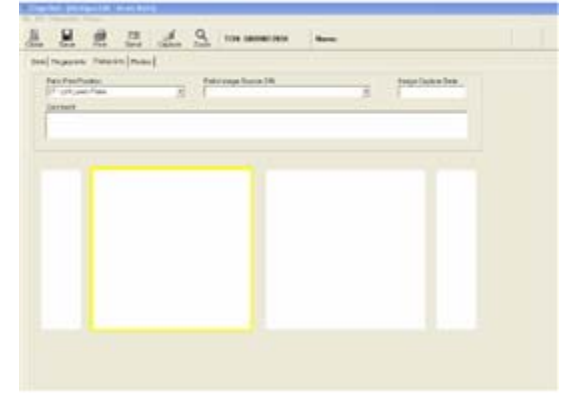
While capturing the writer's palm, rotate hand 45 degrees inward during capture.

PHOTOS

Consists of mug shots, scars, marks and tattoos.

Mug shots

POSE (Frontal): The full-face or frontal pose is the most commonly used pose in photo lineups/facial recognition shall always be captured. This pose is in addition to profiles captured to acquire perspective and other information. There should be no obvious tilt of the head from front to back. Head coverings are not permitted unless for religious reasons but the full-face must be displayed.

Glasses: If the subject wears glasses, at least one image should be captured with glasses and one image without. You must identify the image with glasses as "Front with glasses."

Expression: Subject shall have a neutral expression. It is the operator's responsibility to ensure there are no smiles, grimaces, or overt expressions.

Mouth: Shall be closed.

Accessories: Hats and earrings along with all other accessories shall be removed.

Second mug shot should be of the left profile (subject facing to their right). For every Live Scan transaction you may submit up to 20 photos. Background should be 18% gray and lighting is also very important so not to cast shadows. Reference Michigan Best Practices for further details.

After photos, you should be ready to submit the transaction to the state.

Live Scan return codes. It is very important after submitting a transaction to the state that you verify the response was received and accepted by looking at your message log. Refer to page 2 for return codes. Unless you received a RC000, the transaction must be corrected and re-submitted until you do receive this return code.

LEIN RESPONSES

For every transaction sent by Live Scan, you will receive a **minimum** of two LEIN responses. The first will be from MSP, and the second from the FBI. If you fail to receive either one of the two responses, contact Keith Kramer at (517) 241-0723 to obtain your response(s) for that transaction.

MSP Responses: If subject has no prior arrests, MSP will return no record if the transaction is an ID only. If transaction is a record build, MSP will return a copy of the CHR with the arrest listed along with any previous arrests relating to this subject. Whenever you have a subject with a questionable identity, do not release until you have verified subject's identity (arrest record) through a fingerprint search.

FBI Responses: If subject has a record, they will return an FBI number (not a rap sheet). You then must run (via LEIN) the FBI number to see the subject's out-of-state rap sheet.

COMMON LIVE SCAN ERRORS

REW with CTN #. Entering an arrest disposition code of REW indicates a new arrest (no warrant yet). Entering CTN # (indicating warrant issued) causes the arrest information to go into a problem queue at CRD. You will get back, via LEIN, a verified SID number, along with a message that the transaction is in the problem queue. Do not resend. The data error can be corrected at CRD (by deleting the CTN #). The CHR can be updated with the new arrest information and a completed CHR can be sent showing your new arrest data.

CHG or JUV Arrest. When entering a warrant arrest (CHG or JUV), Live Scan requires a PACC code and CTN # issued by the prosecutor's office. If you are entering a warrant arrest, but at time of booking do not have both of these numbers available, you can elect to do a REW or REP arrest, but leave out the CTN #. In this case the prosecutor will still have to enter their charge data to CHR.

Middle Names. If your subject has more than one middle name, enter their additional names under alias. For example: Smith, John Joseph Michael, enter name as Smith, John Joseph then under alias enter Smith, John Michael. Remember to include last name, first name, middle name and suffix such as JR, IV only. Any additional names must be entered into alias.

No Complaint Number. The Prosecutor/Court segments link to the arrest segment using the TCN/OCA #s. Law enforcement can only use complaint numbers in a format that the Prosecutor/Court can also submit to CHR.

Bench Warrants. Do not build arrest records for bench warrants, failure to appear, or obstructing justice. If the original charge was built, you do not do another record build for a bench warrant. To determine this, you may need to run a QH on name/dob to obtain a SID #, then run the SID # to determine if the original charge was built.
