● **Statewide Information:**

- The overall average of the narcotic offense rate has increased 28% within the last five years in Michigan
- Michigan's estimated population of 10,112,620 is serviced by 589 law enforcement agencies, which totals 18,009 officers
- Michigan is made up of 83 counties with populations ranging from 2,206 in Keweenaw County to 2,021,202 in Wayne County
- Michigan reported 43,115 Narcotic Offenses in 2004, for a rate of 428 offenses per 100,000 residents
- Marijuana accounted for 68% of all Narcotic Arrests in 2004, a decrease from 74% in 2000
- Cocaine accounted for 12% of all Narcotic Arrests in 2004 and 10% in 2000 resulting in a 2% increase within the last 5 years

● **District Information:**

- The Sixth District reported a 48% increase in Narcotic Offense Rate, the largest five year increase for any district in the State of Michigan
- Eighth District reported the lowest increase (3%) in the Narcotic Offense Rate over the last five years
- Once again, Fifth District reported the highest Narcotic Offense Rate in 2004
- All seven districts reported increases over the last five years in proportion to Narcotic Arrests that were for Marijuana
- Districts First, Third, Fifth, and Sixth reported decreases in proportion to Narcotic Arrests for Opium/Cocaine over the last five years
- Eighth District is the only district to report a decrease (-11%) in Narcotic Offense Rate over the last five years
- All seven districts reported a decrease in the proportion of Narcotic Arrests for other drugs over the last five years





The chart above reflects the changes between the years 2000 and 2004. Amphetamine arrests increased 293% within the last five years in the State of Michigan. While LSD arrests decreased by 70%.

● **District Information:**

- First District is composed of nine counties, accounting for 9.24% of Michigan's population. They reported 10.35% of all Narcotic Offenses in 2004
- The district reported an overall increase of 8.01% in Narcotic Arrests between the last 5 years
- Eight out of the nine counties in First District reported an increase over the last five years in proportion to Narcotic Arrests for Amphetamine
- First District reported an increase of 23% in the Narcotic Offense Rate over the last five years, the 5th largest increase among all seven districts
- First District reported the second largest increase in the percentage of all Narcotic Arrests that were for Amphetamine Drugs, increasing a little over 3%
- The district ranked 5th in increases of overall Narcotic Drug Arrests within the last five years (17.5%)

● **County Information:**

- Shiawassee County reported the largest decrease (28%) in the Narcotic Offense Rate over the last five years within First District
- Clinton County reported the highest increase (85%) in the Narcotic Offense Rate over the last five years
- Of the counties that have a population greater than 100,000, Ingham County had the second highest reported Narcotic Offense Rate in the state of Michigan in 2004
- Three out of the nine counties in First District reported decreases in Marijuana arrests. They are Jackson, Livingston, and Shiawassee.
- Eaton County reported the highest increase in arrests for any drug type (202%) in the last five years.




# Narcotic Crime Trends First District 2000-2004







#### ● District Information:

- Second District is composed of six counties, accounting for 47% of Michigan's population. They reported 44% of the Narcotic Offenses in 2004
- All the districts reported an increase in the Narcotic Offense Rate between 2000 and 2004
- Second District reported the second highest percentage of change (34%) between 2000 and 2004
- Second District reported the largest proportion of Narcotic Arrests for Dangerous Drugs (Other) in 2004
- Second District reported the largest increase for Marijuana arrests (32%) between 2000 and 2004
- This is the only district that reported a decrease (38%) in Amphetamine arrests between 2000 and 2004

#### ● County Information:

- Monroe is the only county within Second District to report a decrease in the Narcotic Offense Rate over the last five years (3%)
- Macomb reported the largest increase in the Narcotic Offense Rate (67%) over the last five years for any county in Second District
- Wayne County reported the highest proportion of Narcotic Arrests (31.75%) in 2004
- Macomb reported an increase of 75% in Narcotic Arrests for any drug type over the last five years within the district
- Oakland reported the largest decrease of 89% in proportion to Narcotic Arrests for the drug type Amphetamine over the last five years
- Both Monroe and Washtenaw counties reported the largest increase in proportion to Narcotic Arrests for Synthetic drugs over the last five years (500%)




# Narcotic Crime Trends Second District 2000 - 2004





#### ● District Information:

- Third District is composed of twelve counties, accounting for 12% of the state population. They reported 12% of the Narcotic Offenses for 2004
- Third District reported the second lowest increase in the Narcotic Offense Rate of the seven districts over the last five years (20%)
- Third District reported 11% of the Narcotic Arrests in 2004
- The number of Narcotic Arrests for Opium or Derivative in Third District increased by 250% over the last five years
- Synthetic Drugs reported the second largest increase (76%) in arrests over the last five years

#### ● County Information:

- Four counties in the Third District (Arenac, Huron, Iosco & Tuscola) reported decreases in the Narcotic Offense Rate over the last five years
- Sanilac is the only county in the State of Michigan that reported no change in their Narcotic Offense Rate
- There were two counties (Arenac and Tuscola) that were in the top 10 for reporting the largest percentage of decreases in their Narcotic Offense Rate
- Six out of the 12 counties (Arenac, Huron, Iosco, Saginaw, Sanilac, & Tuscola) reported a decrease in proportion to Narcotic Arrests for Marijuana over the last five years
- Out of the 20 counties that have a population greater than 100,000, Bay County reported the 8th highest the Narcotic Offense Rate in 2004





### 2000 - 2004





**% of Change in Third District Arrests

- Out of the seven districts, Fifth District reported the highest Narcotic Offense Rate in 2004
- Fifth District reported a 29% increase in the Narcotic Offense Rate over the last five years
- Fifth District reported increases in Narcotic Arrests for all drug types over the last five years; except for Barbiturates and LSD Drugs, they have decreased
- Only Cass County reported a decrease in the Narcotic Offense Rate for the last 5 years

- Kalamazoo County reported the largest percentage (24.87%) in Fifth District for the proportion of Narcotic Arrests in 2004
- Out of the 20 counties that have a population greater than 100,000 in the State of Michigan, Berrien, Calhoun, and Kalamazoo counties were among the ten highest reported Narcotic Offense Rates in 2004
- Branch county reported the largest increase in the Narcotic Offense Rate (57%) over the last five years
- Allegan and Kalamazoo counties are the only counties in the Fifth District to report a decrease in the proportion of Narcotic Arrests for Opium or Derivative over the last five years
- Five counties (Barry, Cass, Calhoun, Kalamazoo, and Van Buren) reported a decrease in the proportion of Narcotic Arrests for Marijuana over the last five years
- All nine counties in the Fifth District reported an increase in Narcotic Arrests for Amphetamine between 2000-2004






# Narcotic Crime Trends Fifth District 2000 - 2004




**% of Change in Fifth District Arrests

● **District Information:**

- Sixth District is composed of thirteen counties, accounting for 14.26% of the state population. They reported 15% of the Narcotic Offenses in 2004
- Sixth District reported a 48% increase in the Narcotic Offense rate for the last five years, this is the largest increase among the seven districts
- Sixth District reported a 15.12% in proportion to Narcotic Arrests for Marijuana in 2004, this is the second highest percentage
- Sixth District reported a decrease of 5.66% in proportion to Narcotic Arrests for Amphetamine Drugs over the last five years




### 2000 - 2004





● **District Information:**

- Seventh District is composed of nineteen counties, accounting for 4.70% of the state population. They reported 5% of the Narcotic Offenses in 2004
- Seventh District reported a 30% increase in the Narcotic Offense Rate over the last five years, the 2nd largest increase for any district in the State of Michigan
- Arrests for Marijuana have accounted for 79% or more of all Narcotic Arrests within Seventh District in 2004
- The proportion of Narcotic Arrests for LSD in Seventh District has decreased from 33% to 25% over the last five year
- The proportion of Narcotic Arrests for Synthetic Drugs has increased by 8.36% over the last five years within the Seventh District




## Narcotic Crime Trends Seventh District 2000 - 2004



- Eighth District is composed of the entire Upper Peninsula (15 counties), accounting for 3.26% of the state population. They reported 3% of the Narcotic Offenses in 2004
- Eighth District reported a 3% increase in the Narcotic Offense Rate over the last five years, the lowest increase in the State of Michigan
- Eight counties reported a decrease in the Narcotic Offense Rate over the last five years (Baraga, Delta, Dickinson, Houghton, Iron, Luce, Mackinac, & Marquette)
- The proportion of Narcotic Arrests for Opium and Barbiturates have remained stable over the last five years with a tenth of a change for either category
- Once again, arrests for Marijuana account for 85% of the Narcotic Arrests within Eighth District in 2004, it was 88% in 2000

● **County Information:**

- Marquette county reported the largest percentage of arrests for all drug types in 2004 (19.5%)
- Schoolcraft county reported the largest increase of the Narcotic Offense Rate over the last five years (284%)
- Out of the 15 counties, six of them (Alger, Chippewa, Delta, Iron, Marquette, & Menominee) reported a decrease in Hallucinogen drug arrests over the last five years
- Chippewa county reported 100% of the arrests for Opium or Derivative in 2004
- Luce county reported a decrease of 53% in the Narcotic Offense Rate over the last five years. This is the largest among all the counties in the State of Michigan
- Three counties (Baraga, Luce & Mackinac) were part of the top ten counties to report large decreases in the Narcotic Offense Rate between the last five years in the State of Michigan




### 2000 - 2004
