### *The Law Enforcement Response to Non-Stranger Sexual Assault*

MCOLES and the Domestic Violence Prevention & Treatment Board are funding this free training session for law enforcement patrol officers and sexual assault service providers. The intent is to improve the quality of the response to victims of sexual assault by patrol officers and other first responders.
