The original QVF system was first developed and deployed in the late 1990s. The objective of this project is to refresh the current architecture and software platform (Delphi) to a supported DTMB application standard and update the user interface. It is also to make sure that the current vendor support is a sustainable model for QVF system with its suite of applications such as QVF, QVF-GUI, QVF-Lite, E-Wizard, Street Index and Electronic Poll Book along with hardware and database components.
