Public Comment on State Plan on Aging Accepted Through May 20

LANSING, Mich. – The Michigan Office of Services to the Aging (OSA) is accepting public comment for the fiscal year 2014-2016 State Plan on Aging through May 20, 2013.

The State Plan on Aging - required for federal funding - proposes a policy and program framework for services and supports for Michigan's older adult population.

"We look forward to working with our partners and the public to thoughtfully evaluate what we are doing and figure out new and innovative ways to expand or deliver better services throughout the state."
