Monthly purchase contracts must be completely paid before the beneficiary is expected to enter college. Four-year monthly purchase plans can be purchased for beneficiaries in grades 8 and below; Seven-year monthly purchase plans can be purchased for beneficiaries in grades 5 and below; Ten-year monthly purchase plans can be purchased for beneficiaries in grades 2 and below; and Fifteen-year monthly purchase plans can be purchased for beneficiaries age 3 years and below. **Monthly purchase amounts include 7.01 percent rate of return, therefore the total amount paid will be more than if paid by lump sum.**

- Initial purchase must be a minimum of one credit hour
- Same cost, newborn to adult
- Able to purchase more than one, just multiply the per credit hour cost by the number of desired credit hours
OR
- Deposit any amount over the initial one credit hour cost and MET will calculate the number of credits or (fractions thereof) purchased
- Make additional payments, minimum \$25, at any time
- No obligation to continue

Upon receipt of a payment, MET will determine the number of credit hours (or fraction thereof) earned based upon the published per credit hour price in effect at the time the payment is received. Credit hour costs for each type of contract will be set each enrollment period to be effective on the first day of enrollment and are subject to increases during that enrollment period.

There is a 45 day waiting period between the last payment made to MET by the Purchaser on a Pay-As-You-Go contract and MET's ability to make payment to a higher education institution on behalf of the Beneficiary.
