



Everyday Radiation

Many materials emit small amounts of radiation. It is regulated as **Normally Occurring Radioactive Material**. When a human process disturbs the material, it is called **Technologically Enhanced Normally Occuring Radioactive Material (TENORM)**



At 50 pCi/g, a person would need constant exposure for 8 days to equal a normal chest x-ray.

A picocurie is 1 trillionth of a gram.
