Included on the Agenda will be:

- Consideration of meeting minutes for approval.
- Consideration of AutoMARK Voter Assist Terminal, M100 Tabulator and M650 Central Tabulator modifications submitted for approval by Election Systems & Software of Omaha, Nebraska.
- Consideration of GEMS v.1.21.5 Election Management System software, AccuVote v.1.96.13 models A, B, C and D tabulators, AutoMARK Voter Assist Terminal v. 1.3.3460 models A100, A200 and A300 and AutoMARK Information System software v. 1.3.572 submitted for approval by Premier Election Solutions of Omaha, Nebraska.
- Consideration of initiative petition form submitted for approval by the Dads and Moms PAC, P.O. Box 27271, Lansing, Michigan 48909-7271. (Petition would amend state law to require the Circuit Court to award joint physical and legal custody in a child custody dispute unless there is clear and convincing evidence of unfitness, unwillingness or inability by either parent to equally parent.)
- Consideration of initiative petition form submitted for approval by Michigan Is Yours, 20750 Civic Center #418, Southfield, Michigan 48076. (Petition would amend the State Constitution to authorize casino gaming at no more than seven casinos located in Muskegon, Lansing, Detroit, Detroit/Wayne County Metropolitan Airport, Benton Harbor, Flint and Romulus.)
- Consideration of initiative petition form submitted for approval by Racing to Save Michigan, 1650 E. 10 Mile Road, Hazel Park, Michigan 48030. (Petition would amend the State Constitution to allow the Michigan Gaming Control and Revenue Board to issue state casino licenses to up to eight new casinos in Michigan, five of which would be located at horse racetracks that conducted race meetings with pari-mutuel wagering in 2009.) Note: Petition form originally approved October 14, 2009; resubmitted form contains minor edits.
- Such other and further business as may be properly presented to the Board.
