CALENDAR OF DATES**

May 1	Last day a recall petition can be filed for election. (168.963)
By May 12	Petitions to place proposals on ballot filed with county and local clerks. (If governing law sets an earlier petition filing deadline, earlier deadline must be observed.) (168.646a)
By May 26	Ballot wording of proposals qualified to appear on ballot certified to county and local clerks. (168.646a)
Jun. 25 through Jul. 14	Precinct inspectors appointed for election. (168.674)
By Jun. 29	Notice of close of registration for election published. One notice required. (168.498)
Jul. 7	Last day to register for election. (168.498)
By Jul. 15	Absent voter ballots must be available for issuance to voters. (168.714)
By Jul. 24	Pre-Election Campaign Statements filed (closes Jul. 19).
By Jul. 28	Notice of election published. One notice required. (168.653a)
By Jul. 30	Public accuracy test must be conducted. (R 168.778) Notice of test must be published at least 48 hours before test. (168.798)
By 2:00 p.m., Aug. 1	Electors who wish to receive an absent voter ballot for election by mail submit applications. (168.759)
Up to 4:00 p.m., Aug. 3	Electors qualified to obtain an absent voter ballot for election may vote in person in clerk's office. (168.761)

Up to 4:00 p.m., Aug. 4	Emergency absentee voting for election. (168.759b)
Aug. 4	ELECTION
By Aug. 10	Boards of County Canvassers meet to canvass election. (168.821)
Sep. 3	Post-Election Campaign Statements filed (closes Aug. 24).
