**AUGUST 8, 2017 ELECTION**

**CALENDAR OF DATES**

<b>By May 2</b>	Petitions to place proposals on ballot filed with county and local clerks. ( <a href="#">168.646a</a> )
<b>May 5</b>	Last day a recall petition can be filed for August election. (Recalls filed against Governor, state-level or countywide office only. Does not apply to local offices; see May calendar & November dates below for applicable deadlines.) ( <a href="#">168.963</a> )
<b>By 4:00 p.m., May 16</b>	Ballot wording of proposals qualified to appear on primary election ballot certified to county and local clerks. ( <a href="#">168.646a</a> )
<b>By June 24</b>	Clerks shall electronically transmit or mail (as requested) an absent voter ballot to each absent UOCAVA (uniformed services or overseas) voter who applied for an absent voter ballot 45 days or more before the election (MOVE deadline.) ( <a href="#">168.759a</a> )
<b>By June 24</b>	Absent voter ballots must be available for issuance to voters. ( <a href="#">168.714</a> )
<b>June 29 through July 18</b>	Precinct inspectors appointed by local election commission for election. ( <a href="#">168.674</a> )
<b>By July 3</b>	Notice of close of registration for election published. ( <a href="#">168.498</a> )
<b>July 10</b>	Last day to register for election. ( <a href="#">168.497</a> )
<b>By July 28</b>	Pre-Election Campaign Statements filed (closes July 23).
<b>By August 1</b>	Notice of election published. One notice required. ( <a href="#">168.653a</a> )

<b>By August 3</b>	Public accuracy test must be conducted by local election commission. (R 168.778) Notice of test must be published at least 48 hours before test. (168.798)
<b>By 2:00 p.m., August 5</b>	Electors who wish to receive an absent voter ballot for election by mail submit applications. (168.759)
<b>By 4:00 p.m., August 7</b>	Electors qualified to obtain an absent voter ballot for election may vote in person in clerk's office. (168.761)
<b>Up to 4:00 p.m., August 8</b>	Emergency absentee voting for election. (168.759b)
<b>August 8</b>	<b>ELECTION</b>
<b>Before 11:00 a.m., August 9</b>	Local clerk delivers results of election to county clerk. (168.809)
<b>By August 14</b>	Boards of County Canvassers meet to canvass election. (168.821)
<b>By September 7</b>	Post-Election Campaign Statements filed (closes August 28).
