





YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED THAT THE BOARD OF STATE CANVASSERS WILL CONDUCT A HEARING ON SEPTEMBER 7, 2012 AT 1:30 P.M. IN ROOM 426 OF THE STATE CAPITOL BUILDING, LANSING, MICHIGAN.

Included on the Agenda will be:

- Consideration of meeting minutes for approval.
- Canvass and certification of the September 5, 2012 special primary election.
- Certification of nominees for the office of Judge of the Circuit Court, 56th Circuit.
- Assignment of ballot designations to statewide ballot proposals qualified to appear on the November 6, 2012 general election ballot.
- Determination of ballot wording for the statewide proposals identified below:
 - PROTECT OUR JOBS:** Proposed constitutional amendment to create a new constitutional right of collective bargaining.
 - CITIZENS FOR MORE MICHIGAN JOBS:** Proposed constitutional amendment to authorize the establishment of 8 new casinos at specific locations in Detroit, Clam Lake Township, DeWitt Township, Pontiac, Clinton Township, Birch Run Township, Grand Rapids, and Romulus.
- Certification of Amended Election Management System Unity Software v.3.0.1.0, including M100 tabulator firmware change v.5.3.1.0, to accommodate Oakland County's plan for wireless transmission of unofficial election night results, submitted for approval by Election Systems & Software of Omaha, Nebraska.
- Report on the recount of votes cast at the August 7, 2012 primary election, if any recounts are completed prior to the hearing.
- Such other and further business as may be properly presented to the Board.
