Agenda item: Establishment of deadline for challenging signatures sampled from the constitutional amendment petitions submitted to the Secretary of State in 2012.

Board action on agenda item: The Board moved that the deadline for challenging signatures sampled from the constitutional amendment petitions submitted on or before July 9, 2012, elapse at 5:00 p.m. on the tenth business day after copies of the signatures sampled from the petition are made available to the public. 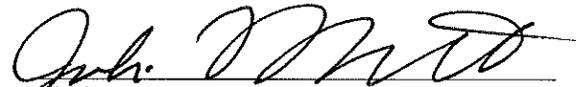
Agenda item: Vote to go into closed session to discuss a memorandum of legal advice from the Department of Attorney General.

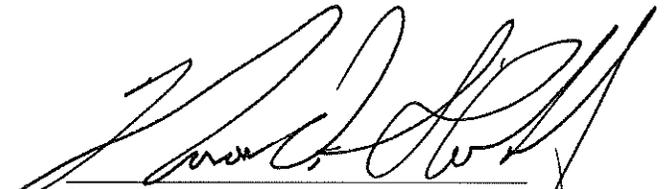

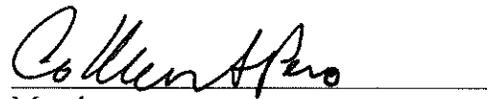

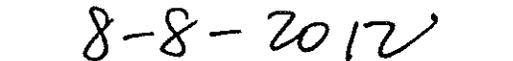
