

# CDL License Information

## What Do I Need to Bring?

- **U.S. Citizenship or Legal Presence Documentation:** Documents showing proof of legal presence can be:
  - a valid U.S. Passport or Passport Card
  - Original or certified copy of birth certificate bearing an official seal or stamp
  - Certificate of Naturalization (N-550, N570 or N-578)
  - Certificate of U.S. Citizenship (N-560 or N-561)
  - Other legal presence documents listed under “Documents Required for a License or ID (SOS-428)” available on the Secretary of State website at [www.Michigan.gov/sos](http://www.Michigan.gov/sos)

**NOTE:** Haz Mat drivers must be U.S. citizens or Lawful Permanent Residents.

- **Social Security Documentation:**

- Social Security card
- payroll check stub
- W-2 Form

**NOTE:** the document must show the entire Social Security number.

- **Current Michigan or Out-of-State Driver’s License**
- **DOT Medical Card:** When operating outside the State of Michigan unless exempt. See Commercial Driver License Manual Section 1 page ii for Exemptions.
- **FMCSA Vision/Diabetes Exemption Document** (if applicable)

## Cost:

- \$35.00 to upgrade to a Chauffeur License
- \$45.00 to upgrade to an Enhanced Operator License
- \$50.00 to upgrade to an Enhanced Chauffeur License
- \$25.00 Commercial Learner’s Permit (CLP)
- \$5.00 Each Endorsements (Passenger, School Bus or Tank))

## Testing Requirements:

- Testing is offered until one half hour before closing
- You are eligible to take required tests once per day
- You must hold your Commercial Learner’s Permit (CLP) a minimum of 14 days before taking your road skills test.
- You must schedule your road skills test a minimum of two days in advance.
