


# Obtaining a Driver's License

<p>Note: Only U.S. citizens and permanent legal residents may apply for a Michigan driver's license.</p> <p>Read:</p> <p>"What Every Driver Must Know"</p> <p>"Driving Skills Test Study Guide"</p>	<p>Present proof of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Social Security number or ineligibility for one</li> <li>• U.S. Citizenship or legal presence</li> <li>• Identity</li> <li>• Residency</li> </ul>	<p>Pass vision test, road signs test and physical standards</p> <p>Pass knowledge test - given at branch office, required to get a TIP</p> <p>Pay \$25 fee for TIP:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Valid for 180 days</li> <li>• Required to take driving skills test</li> </ul>	<p>Must have a TIP to practice driving</p> <p>Must be with a licensed adult or driver education instructor</p> <p>Must practice for at least 30 days</p>	<p>Given by third-party testing organization</p> <p>Fees and hours vary</p> <p>Test consists of two parts:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Basic control skills</li> <li>• On-the-road driving requirements</li> </ul>	<p>After passing skills test, take skills test certificate, TIP and identification to branch office</p> <p>License will be issued</p> <p>No fee</p> <p>Restrictions may apply for medical conditions</p> <p>First license - three-year probation</p>
