

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED THAT THE BOARD OF STATE CANVASSERS WILL MEET ON JULY 23, 2012 AT 2:00 P.M. IN ROOM 426 OF THE STATE CAPITOL BUILDING, LANSING, MICHIGAN.

Included on the Agenda will be:

- Consideration of meeting minutes for approval.
- Report on review of nominating petitions filed with the Secretary of State for the September 5, 2012 special primary election.
- Establish deadline for challenging signatures on constitutional amendment petitions filed by:
 - Protect Our Jobs, 5859 West Saginaw Highway No. 142, Lansing, Michigan 48917-2460. (Petition proposes to amend the State Constitution to create a new constitutional right to collective bargaining.)
 - Citizens for More Michigan Jobs, 2408 Lake Lansing Road, Lansing, Michigan 48912. (Petition proposes to amend the State Constitution to authorize the establishment of 8 new casinos at specific locations in Detroit, Clam Lake Township, DeWitt Township, Pontiac, Clinton Township, Birch Run Township, Grand Rapids, and Romulus.)
 - Michigan Energy, Michigan Jobs, P.O. Box 873, East Lansing, Michigan 48826. (Petition proposes to amend the State Constitution to require utilities to obtain at least 25% of their electricity from clean renewable energy sources.)
 - Citizens for Affordable Quality Home Care, 400 Galleria Office Centre, Suite 117, Southfield, Michigan 48034. (Petition proposes to amend the State Constitution to establish the Michigan Quality Home Care Council, provide certain information to consumers, require training of providers, and provide limited collective bargaining rights.)
 - Michigan Alliance for Prosperity, 222 West Genesee, Lansing, Michigan 48933. (Petition proposes to amend the State Constitution to prohibit the imposition of new or additional taxes or expansion of the base of taxation by the State of Michigan unless approved by a 2/3 majority of members in each chamber of the Legislature or by a statewide vote of the people.)
 - The People Should Decide, 12225 Stephens Road, Warren, Michigan 48089. (Petition proposes to amend the State Constitution to require a vote of the people before the State of Michigan can construct or finance new international bridges or tunnels for motor vehicles.)

- A vote will be taken to determine whether the Board will meet in closed session to discuss a memorandum of advice from Board counsel.
- Such other and further business as may be properly presented to the Board.
