


Redistricting ID Cards Module - Mass Producing Voter ID Cards after the Redistricting Process.

Voter ID cards can be printed individually or in batches using the Mass Producing Voter ID Cards (Figure 1.24). The Redistricting ID Cards Module (Figure 1.26) is for sending out batch cards based on selected change criteria after the redistricting process has been done by the State.

Action	Result
Click on <i>Redistricting ID Cards</i> .	The <i>Redistricting ID Cards</i> screen is displayed. Figure 1.26
Select Jurisdiction as the Region Type from the dropdown menu under Region .	Jurisdiction is selected as the Region Type.

<p>Select the Precincts for which you want to send ID Cards</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Select ‘Select All’ to select all listed precincts - Select ‘Select None’ to remove the selection - Individually select multiple precincts
<p>Select Address Options to Include</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All voters regardless of mailing address - Voters with mailing addresses - Voters without mailing addresses
<p>Select Labels button</p>	<p>The Redistrict Card Mailing Labels dialog box appears with Preview and Print Options (Print Now/Print Later).</p> <p>SPECIAL NOTE: The “labels” option will generate mailing labels for all voters with an alternative mailing address, and can be used for ID card mailings for those voters with an</p>

	alternative mailing address <u>that includes a PO box</u> (i.e., the PO box must be used in order for the voter to receive the ID card). This option should <u>not</u> be used for ID card mailings for voters with non-PO types of alternative mailing addresses (such as out-of-jurisdiction street addresses).
Select the Voter Statuses to include	Include the following voters: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Active - Challenged - To Be Verified
Select which type of card you wish to Generate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - ID Cards - Master Cards
Select the Card Type you wish to generate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - QVF Printed - Pre Printed
