In Michigan, nearly half the motorcycle riders killed in crashes lack a cycle endorsement. While rider training and increased visibility reduce motorcyclist deaths and injuries, only 5 percent of Michigan motorcyclists wear any kind of high-visibility clothing or gear.

A new effort aims to boost endorsements and visibility. Anyone passing a state/public-sponsored training course, including the Advanced Rider Course, will receive a free high-visibility motorcycle vest (while supplies last).
