

Data Packet for 2012 Release, Retain Info v. 16-02-02

Introduction

During the five-year period starting in 2010 there have been 331 schools identified as Persistently Lowest Achieving (PLA) or Priority. The PLA metric was used in both 2010 and 2011. Since 2012 the Top-to-Bottom metric has been implemented. Schools remain in their respective cohorts for at least four years.

The number of schools that will be released from the 2013 and 2014 Cohorts will depend on the schools' performance on all exit criteria. Schools must meet all the following three exit criteria:

1. **Top-to-Bottom Requirement (TTB)**: The school must have a TTB percentile rank of 5 or higher.
2. **Annual Measurable Objective (AMOs)**: The school must meet its AMOs for both math and reading in the all-students subgroup.
3. **Assessment Participation Requirement**: The school must have at least a 95% participation rate on all required state assessments.

¹ This includes two buildings which are Shared Education Entities (SEE) and one building that missed its Mathematics target but whose 2014 Top-to-Bottom rank was 85.

- 43 are located within Wayne County (49%)

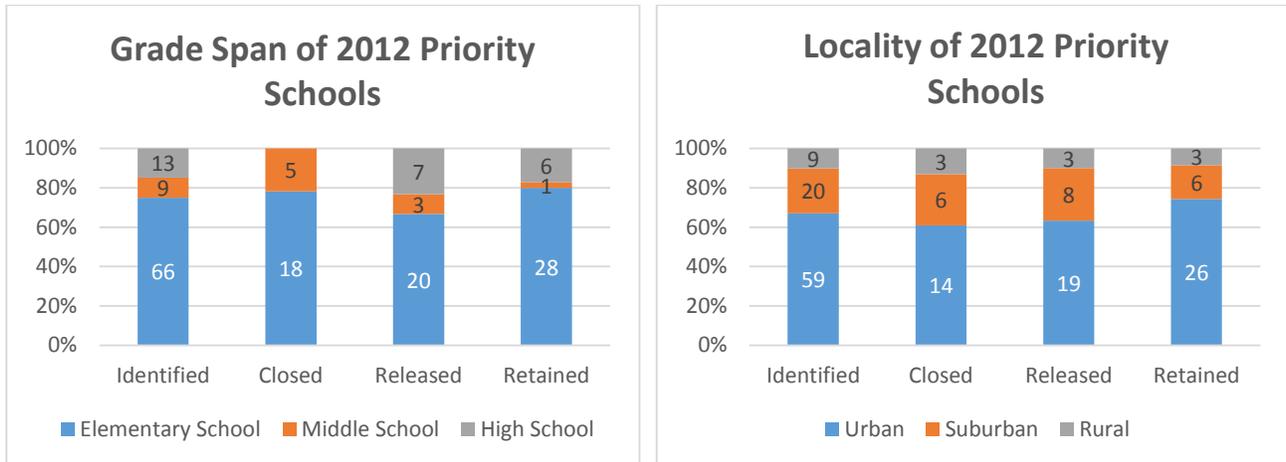

Overall Description of the 2012 Priority Cohort

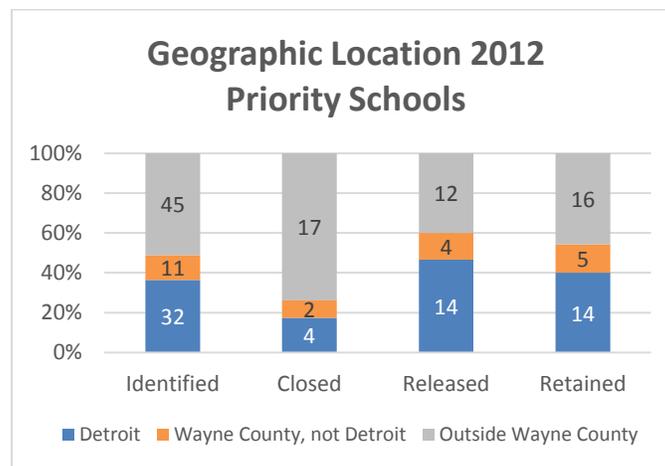
Charts 1 and 2. The 2012 Cohort disaggregated by grade span and locality type.



Data Points for Charts 1 and 2

- In the 2012 cohort, 67% of the 88 schools identified were urban.
- Elementary schools made up 75% of schools identified and 80% of those retained.
- Twenty three schools were closed by local districts; none of which were high schools.

Chart 3. The 2012 Cohort disaggregated by geographic location.

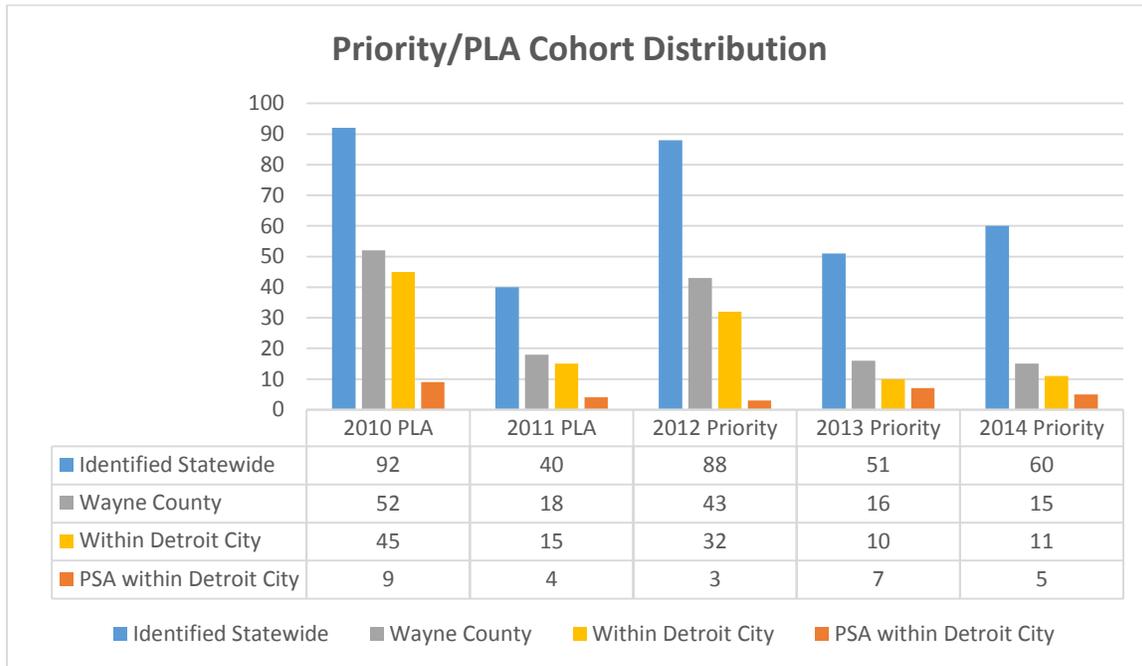


Data Points for Chart 3

- Of the 23 schools closed, only four were in the city limits of Detroit.
- In the 2012 cohort, 10% of the schools identified were rural.
- Middle schools made up 10% schools identified and 3% of those retained.

Chart 4. Each of the five cohorts disaggregated by geographical locations of Wayne County, the city of Detroit and Public School Academies (PSA) in the city limits of Detroit.

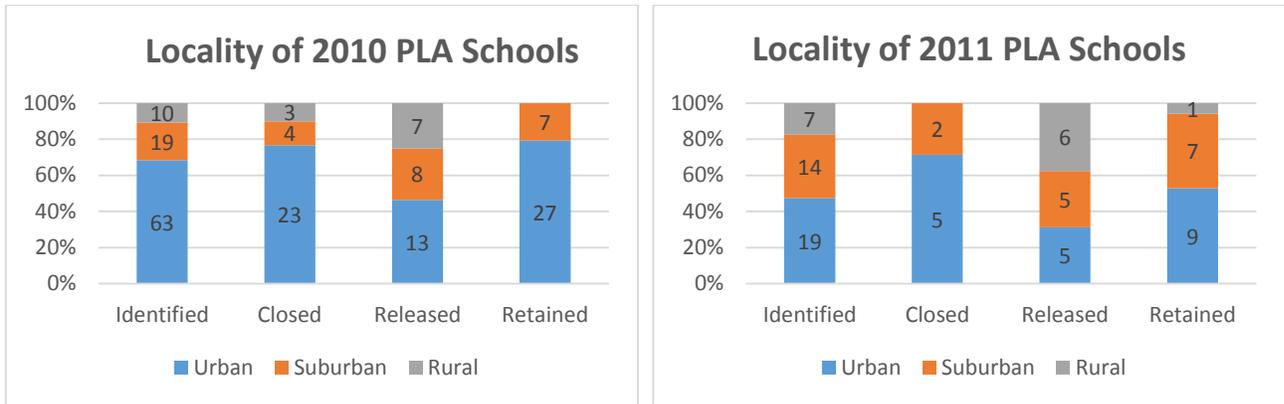


Data Points for Chart 4

- Of counties statewide, Wayne County has the greatest percentage of schools that were identified in each cohort.
- A majority of schools identified as Priority in Wayne County are in the city limits of Detroit.
- Forty-three of the 88 schools identified in the 2012 Cohort were located in Wayne County. Of these 43 schools in Wayne County 32 are in the city limits of Detroit. Of the 32 schools in the city limits of Detroit all 32 are governed by Detroit Public Schools (3 as PSAs, 29 as traditional schools).

Descriptive Information for the Previous 2010 and 2011 PLA Cohorts

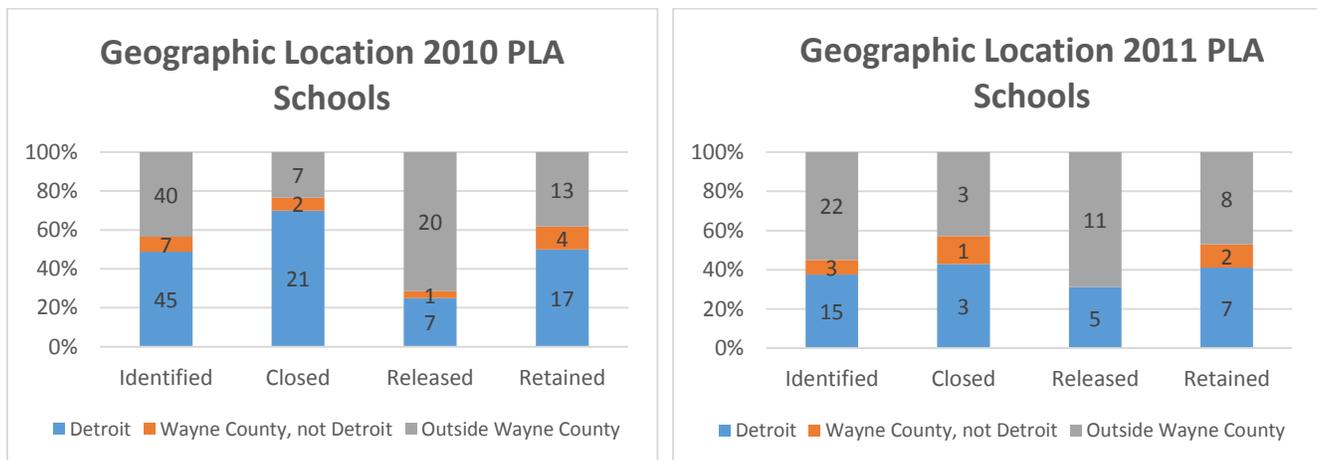
Charts 5 and 6. The 2010 and 2011 Cohorts disaggregated by status and locality type.



Data Points for Charts 5 and 6

- In the 2010 cohort, 79% of the schools retained were in urban areas.
- In the 2011 cohort, 48% of the schools identified were urban, and make up 53% of those retained.

Charts 7 and 8. The 2010 and 2011 Cohorts disaggregated by status and geographic location.



Data Points for Charts 7 and 8

- In the 2010 cohort, most schools that were closed by district decision were within Detroit.
- In the 2011 cohort, most identified schools were outside of Wayne County.
