IFTA IS CHANGING!

Michigan is implementing a new, online IFTA system. This means:

- Beginning with the Fourth Quarter 2014 reporting period (the tax return that is due January 31, 2015), you will be required to electronically file your IFTA returns using the new system.
- For the 2015 License Year, Renewal Season will begin on **December 8, 2014**. Note that paper license applications will not be accepted.
- We are requesting that you submit your Third Quarter 2014 tax return and/or payments by Monday, **October 13, 2014**. This will help avoid potential problems and delays.
