The State Tax Commission (Commission) has received a resolution passed on June 4, 2015 from the City of Escanaba regarding the revocation of Obsolete Property Rehabilitation Certificate Number 3-05-0027, issued to Gehring Rentals, transferred to H2 Development LLC, and located at 720 Ludington Street in the City of Escanaba.

Public Act 146 of 2000, the Obsolete Property Rehabilitation Act (Act), provides for the revocation of a certificate by the legislative body of the qualified local governmental unit. The Act does not require action by the Commission following the revocation by a qualified local governmental unit. However, the Commission acknowledges the revocation of Certificate number 3-05-0027 as approved by the City of Escanaba and the resolution will be filed for future reference.

A party aggrieved by the issuance, refusal to issue, revocation, transfer or modification of this exemption certificate may appeal a final decision by filing a petition with the Michigan Tax Tribunal, www.michigan.gov/taxtrib, within 35 days. MCL 205.735a (6).
