DO-NOT-CALL CONSUMER COMPLAINT FILING INFORMATION

Beginning October 1, 2003, you can file a do-not-call complaint with the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) and the Michigan Attorney General. The FTC complaint form will be available at: www.ftc.gov/donotcall using the File a Complaint page. The Michigan Attorney General's do-not-call complaint form will be available here.

Michigan law establishes the national do-not-call registry administered by the FTC as Michigan's do-not-call list. For more information on Michigan's do-not-call law, see the Attorney General's Consumer Alert entitled "[New Michigan Telemarketing Laws, Do-Not-Call List.](#)"

The most recent registration information is available at www.ftc.gov/donotcall. If you register on the FTC's national registry by August 31, 2003, you should start receiving fewer telemarketing calls by October 1, 2003. If you register after September 1, 2003, telemarketers covered by the National Do Not Call Registry will have up to three months from the date you register to stop calling you.
