

**STATE ASSESSORS BOARD
2007-2008 RENEWAL SCHEDULE**

All assessing officers must attend six hours of continuing education during each educational renewal period. The current educational renewal period runs from October 1, 2007 through September 30, 2008. For this renewal period, the State Assessors Board has adopted a mandatory renewal program that will be offered at many locations throughout the state. **Only attendance at this mandatory renewal program (combined with successful completion of the associated quiz) will meet the annual continuing education requirement for assessing officers for the current renewal period.**

Sessions of this mandatory renewal program which have been scheduled to date are listed below. It is planned that additional sessions of the program will be added until roughly 25 to 30 sessions are scheduled. These sessions will be geographically dispersed throughout the state. Please plan accordingly. To register for a session, please call the contact person listed for that session. The list of scheduled programs shown below will be updated periodically as additional program sessions are arranged. The mandatory renewal program for the current renewal period is comprised of three segments: (1) Usage of the *Assessor's Manual*, Volumes I and II; (2) Land Values, Land Value Maps, and Economic Condition Factors; and (3) Application of New, Loss, Additions, Losses, and Adjustment.
