

## **2008-2011 State Tax Commission Six-Hour Renewal Programs**

The State Tax Commission has partnered with the Michigan Assessors Association (MAA) to provide quizzes on the MAA Website that can be used to complete the six-hour renewal requirement. Offering on-line quizzes is an enhancement in service to assessing officers and results in administrative efficiencies for the staff serving the State Tax Commission. The State Tax Commission is thankful to the MAA for their cooperation in hosting these quizzes.

Currently, there are two State Tax Commission renewal programs and quizzes available in an on-line version: 1) Application of New, Loss, Additions, Losses, and Adjustment, and 2) Land Values, Land Value Maps, and Economic Condition Factors. Hard copies of the on-line renewal programs and quizzes are available as some assessing officers may find it easier to complete a quiz by using a hard copy and then transferring the answers to the on-line quiz. Assessing officers will need their certification number and the last six digits of their driver's license number to take an on-line quiz. You may contact the State Tax Commission at 517-335-3429 with any difficulties signing into the quiz. Notification of quiz results will be provided immediately after submitting the quiz. Those who are not initially successful in taking a quiz will need to take the quiz again until it is passed. Although State Tax Commission staff will be notified by email of all quiz results, it is suggested for those who successfully complete the quiz that they print and retain the results notification page. Credit for successful quizzes will be posted for the appropriate renewal year to the Commission's Website in a report titled *Assessor Renewal Credit Status Report*.
