It would be convenient if we could look this up somehow. We always contact the company and do the typical asking around to get our answers, but sometimes this is not a time-friendly way to research, so we were thinking there may be a more efficient/online method?

We have found that the business lookup feature available through DELEG is great. It can be found at [http://www.dleg.state.mi.us/bcs\\_corp/sr\\_corp.asp](http://www.dleg.state.mi.us/bcs_corp/sr_corp.asp) (not a live link). We would suggest you search by "key words" because this will give the most possible choices unless you know the exact name of the corporation. This will also give you the DBA's in case there is a parent company or LLC, etc. as an owner.
