

# Never pay a fee for filing an unemployment claim!

## Beware of websites that charge a fee to file your claim for unemployment benefits

These sites are **not endorsed** by the State of Michigan, and they could:

- Expose personal information to identity theft
- Jeopardize your eligibility for benefits
- Cause a delay in receiving your benefits

## File for unemployment benefits through Michigan's Unemployment Insurance Agency and avoid fees

The state's Unemployment Insurance Agency (UIA) provides two **fee-free** methods for filing unemployment claims. You can file:

- Online at [www.michigan.gov/ui](http://www.michigan.gov/ui)

The website to file your claim is available from 7:00 a.m. Monday through 7:00 p.m. Saturday.

- By calling UIA's toll-free claims line — **1-866-500-0017**

The telephone claims line is open from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday – Friday.
