Background: The federal Wagner-Peyser Act of 1933 provides for the establishment of a nationwide labor exchange system with Employment Service offices that provide job matching at no cost to all employers and job seekers known as the Employment Service (ES). The Act was amended by the WIA of 1998 and more recently by the WIOA of 2014, which calls for stronger partnerships with ES to seek new avenues to enhance the seamless delivery of services in the One-Stop system.

Policy: This policy change increases the current and total allocations for GST Michigan Works! based on funds that were redistributed from Genessee/Shiawassee Michigan Works! due to the realignment of MWAs, effective October 1, 2015. See allocation table (Attachment A). GST Michigan Works! has submitted documentation under WDA PI: 15-10 Change 1, dated October 16, 2015. No further action is required.

All other requirements from WDA PI: 15-10, dated June 30, 2015, and any subsequent policies, remain in effect.
