Subject: WARN Notice

Dear Sir or Madam:

In accordance with the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act (WARN), please be notified that the decision has been made to cease manufacturing operations and close the Detroit (Caraco Pharmaceutical Laboratories, Ltd.) facility located at Elijah McCoy Detroit, MI on or around June 30, 2014. Caraco designates this date as the first of a 14-day window period, as provided under the WARN regulations, for the plant closure to occur. The plant closing is expected to be permanent.

The Company has provided 60 days' advance written notice of the facility closure to all affected non-union represented employees. The manufacturing employees are represented by a union (Local 1, Service Employees International Union, CTW). Notice of such closure has similarly been provided to the union. The name and address of the chief elected officer of such union is Tom Blanoff, President, Local 1 Service Employees International Union, CTW, 111 E. Upper Wacker Drive, Suite 2500, Chicago, IL 60601.

Attached to this letter is a listing of the job titles of all positions affected and the number of employees in each classification. Bumping rights exist for union represented employees within their classification according to the terms of the parties' collective bargaining agreement. Bumping rights do not exist for non-union represented employees.

By copy of this letter notice is being provided to the Honorable Mayor Michael Duggan, chief elected official for the City of Detroit.
