Re: Warning Letter (Executive Order of the Governor 2020-110)

Dear Mr. Glantz:

As you know, under her ongoing authority to issue Executive Orders pursuant to a declared state of emergency, Governor Gretchen Whitmer issued Executive Order 2020-110. Executive Order 2020-110 requires theaters outside of regions 6 and 8 to remain closed. A willful violation of Executive Order 2020-110 is a crime—a misdemeanor under MCL 10.33.

The Attorney General has been made aware of your intention to open a theater, controlled by you, in violation of Executive Order 2020-110. This would be against the law and subject you and possibly others to criminal prosecution if this occurs.

In the interest of public health, you are urged to immediately cancel plans to open your theaters until it is lawful to do so. The Attorney General will criminally prosecute violations if local authorities do not.
