RFQ Questions and Answer #1

Q1 The RFQ requires prequalification for demo, and indicates that the prequalification application must be submitted by May 4, which has passed. Is this a typo?

A1 Yes. Contractors that are not yet prequalified are encouraged to submit their prequalification application as soon as possible. The process for obtaining prequalification takes time and MDOT cannot guarantee the process will be completed if applications are submitted at a specific date.

Q2 If a company teamed with another contractor who was prequalified, would the company also need to be pre-qualified?

A2 The prime contractor needs to be prequalified. If a company is a subcontractor to the prequalified prime contractor they would not have to be prequalified.
