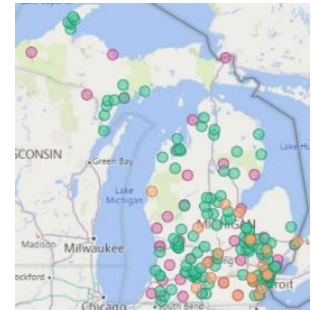

MI School Data – New Report: Michigan Early Middle College Locations

A new report will be released soon allowing users to search for Michigan education entities providing **Early Middle College (EMC)** programs and the districts sending students to these programs. This new interactive map will show EMC location data for school years from 2016-17 to 2020-21 and will be updated annually. The design will have three (3) navigation features:



- **Home** - background information and definitions
- **Locations and Focus Area** – allows users to search for EMC programs throughout Michigan by location and filter by EMC focus area
- **Sending Districts** - users can search for districts by EMC programs by location

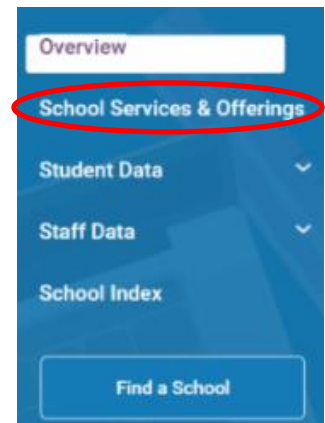
MI School Data News and Updates



→ MI School Data will be intermittently unavailable due to maintenance on **Sunday, November 7, 2021 from 6:00 a.m. to Noon**. Only limited inquiries will be available during this time.

→ Reminder to verify that your district Educational Entity Master (EEM) authorized users have updated any changes to the schools' select programs and services. **The next window to submit updates to CEPI is Wednesday, December 1, 2021.**

Recently Released (2020-21 data unless otherwise noted)

- **Achievement Gap** - users with secure access will be able to view comparisons of student achievement on state standardized tests for a variety of subgroups.
- **Continuity of Service in Special Education** – reports show early intervention and special education services delivered to Michigan children during three important age spans: birth to third birthday, third birthday to kindergarten entry, and kindergarten to third grade.
 - **Service Comparisons** report shows the percentage of students receiving services in each age group for a selected ISD compared to the statewide percentage.
 - **Service Pathways** report shows the number and percentage of children receiving services in each age group, as well as when children began and finished receiving services.
- **Educator Effectiveness** – report shows how school districts rated the effectiveness of their teachers and administrators.
- **K-3 Absenteeism and Early Childhood Participation** – displays attendance rates of K-3 students who participated in state-federal funded EC programs before entering kindergarten.
- **Parent Dashboard** – the following metrics have been updated.
 - **Teacher Retention** – shows how many teachers are retained year over year at the same school (2019-20 data).
 - **Teacher Years of Experience** – displays the median years of Michigan teaching experience for teachers.
 - **Peer Data** – provides average data for each metric from up to 30 schools that are geographically nearby or have similar characteristics to the selected location.
- **Workforce and CTE Reports** - In collaboration with the Department of Labor and Economic Opportunity, the recently updated reports represent information about CTE students in high school, postsecondary education, and the workforce.
- **English Learner Assessment** - reports show English Learners' proficiency, proficiency levels and scaled scores on the WIDA ACCESS assessment for ELs.
- **English Learner Student Growth** - report shows how much EL students progressed in learning the English language, as compared to their EL peers, measured across two consecutive years of the WIDA ACCESS test.
- **Student Attendance** - data showing attendance rates for all students, chronically absent students, and not chronically absent students.
- **Student Growth** - report represents changes in scores for students who have taken two or more consecutive state assessment tests in Michigan. Student growth is represented by the Student Growth Percentile, which groups students with a similar score history and compares their most recent performance.
- **Student Mobility** - compares numbers of students transferring to, transferring from, and remaining in a district after fall count day.
