MI School Data User Migration

Beginning in summer 2020, all MI School Data secure users will need a [third party MILogin account](#) with the same email address as their current MI School Data account to access secure data. Users who don't already have this type of MILogin account must create one prior to the migration to retain access to secure data. If this is not done prior to the migration, users will need to fill out a security form and request a new account. Please refer to the [MILogin/MI School Data Instructions](#) for information on how to set up your MILogin account now to ensure continued access to your data.

Recently Released in Preview

- The [Retained in Grade](#) report, which shows counts and percentages of students who were enrolled in the same grade level for two consecutive years, has been updated with 2019-20 data. This report will be publicly available within a week.

Recently Released to the Public

- School of choice and other resident statuses for traditional and charter districts have been updated with 2019-20 data in the [Non-Resident Status](#) report.
- The following [Parent Dashboard](#) metrics have been updated:
 - **Ratio of Students to Instructional Staff** has been updated with 2019-20 data.
 - **Postsecondary Completion Rate** and **Postsecondary Persistence Rate** have been updated with 2018-19 data.

Coming Soon

- 2018-19 data will be added to the [Student Pathways](#) report for users with secure logins. This report shows student-level information on college enrollment, coursework, cumulative credit, program and award information, and GPAs from in-state and out-of-state colleges and

universities.

- Postsecondary data showing enrollment, credit accumulation, remedial coursework and degree attainment, along with select demographic breakdowns for each high school graduating class, is packaged in the [Student Pathways Aggregate for High School](#) report. 2018-19 data will be added.
- The [Success Rates](#) report will be updated with 2018-19 data, as well as new interactive functionalities. This report shows the number of degree-seeking students achieving successful outcomes at Michigan's public universities and community colleges.
